

Saint Mary's University Parental Consent and Release of Liability

This agreement must be completed in full, signed, and dated before the participant can attend the Shakespeare by the Sea Summer Camp, organized by Saint Mary's University and Shakespeare by the Sea (SBTS).

Name of Activity: Shakespeare by the Sea Summer Camp

This is a 5-day event from **August 13-17*, 2018** that will be held in the SBTS building in Point Pleasant Park. Kids will engage in acting games, learn a scene from one of Shakespeare's plays, and they will present the play to parents on the last day of the camp (the "Activity"). Participants will be required to wear appropriate clothing for the weather. All participants will be required to bring their own lunch and water bottle; a drinking fountain is available to refill at all times. No peanut products will be permitted due to confirmed or potential allergies. Children with any allergies will be required to advise at the time of registration. Chaperones will not administer medications or provide treatments but medication is allowed on-site, with child to self-administer if required.

This activity is an exceptional educational opportunity, but is not without certain risks, dangers, hazards, and liabilities to participants. These include, but are not limited to

1. **PERSONAL INJURY:** All manner of injury or death including cuts and scratches and injuries resulting from slips, trips and falls.
2. **WEATHER:** Any injury or illness resulting from the effects of heat and strong sunlight or exposure to cold, wet or windy weather, including gales, hurricanes and lightning.
3. **TERRAIN:** Any manner of injury resulting from falls on hard, slippery or uneven pathways, roads, sidewalks or any manner of injury resulting from falls on boat decks, or docks.
4. **EQUIPMENT AND TOOLS:** Any manner of injury resulting from use, misuse, non-use and failure of any equipment.
5. **ILLNESS:** Including illness or death due to diseases or other factors including but not limited to allergens, viruses and various bacteria.
6. **ANIMALS:** Including but not limited to squirrels, snakes, insects, unleashed dogs or other domestic or non-domestic animals.
7. **PERSONAL PROPERTY:** Theft, vandalism and/or loss of personal property.
8. **CANCELLATION OR DELAY:** Of the program or curtailment or cancellation of individual activities due to weather, illness, or other circumstances either within or beyond the control of the University.

Parents/Guardians of children taking part in the activity are required to accept these and other risks as a condition of their child's participation in this activity. Parents/Guardians will be required to sign the *Parental Consent and Release of Liability* below, which would release Saint Mary's University and Shakespeare by the Sea and their representatives from any future claims, which might arise as a result of participation in this activity.

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IN CONSIDERATION OF the Child named below (the "Child") being permitted to participate in the Shakespeare by the Sea Summer Camp activities (the "Activities"), I, _____ (please print) the undersigned parent or legal guardian of the Child, on behalf of myself and any other parent or legal guardian of the Child, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby:

1. Acknowledge that I have read and understand that the scope of the Activities includes the elements as described on page 1 hereof and supplemental camp publications.
2. Acknowledge that certain risks of injury are inherent to participation in the Activities and understand that serious injury, and even death, is possible in such participation and may result from the Child's actions, the actions or interactions of others, or a combination of both.
3. Give permission for the Child to participate in the Activities and assume all liability for risk of or harm to the Child associated with such participation.
4. Release and forever discharge and hold harmless Saint Mary's University and Shakespeare by the Sea (collectively the "Organizers", and individually an "Organizer") and their staff, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns (collectively the "Releasees") of and from any and all liability, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, legal costs, actions, and causes of action (collectively, the "Claims") in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to the Child, arising or to arise by reason of, and/or during, the Child's participation in the Activities.
5. Consent to any Organizers administering, or consenting to the administration of, such emergency medical care to the Child as such person deems appropriate in the circumstances; including transportation to a medical facility by ambulance, as deemed necessary, at my expense.
6. Understand and acknowledge that the Organizers do not carry or maintain medical or disability insurance coverage for the Child, and therefore agree to assume responsibility for insurance coverage for the Child.
7. Give permission to have photos of my child taken during the Activities and used in future promotional literature on our website. The child's name will not be used.
