

Campground Rules & Information

1. **SUNDANCE LODGES is a private FAMILY CAMPGROUND with strict QUIET HOURS from 10:30pm - 8am.**

- **Between 10:30pm and 8:00am - Music & Generators must be turned OFF. Keep voices low.**
- **Daytime - Run generators sparingly. Music & voices must be heard only within your site.**
- **Alcohol - consume ONLY on your campsite; do not carry around the campground.**
- **Offensive behavior is not allowed at any time. Report disturbances to the office asap the next morning.**

2. **NO REFUNDS/ CREDITS** for any reason after 3:00pm on your check-in day.

3. **FIREWOOD: collecting deadwood (scavenging) is illegal in Kananaskis Country. Fines start @ \$250.00.**

You may bring firewood as long as it is from Alberta or buy it at the Trading Post. And please don't pick the flowers!

4. **TENTS: place on gravel pad or you will be asked to move them.** Picnic tables must be left in original location.

5. **SPEED LIMIT: 15km/hr** - please watch for children playing. All terrain vehicles/dirt bikes not allowed.

6. **PETS: must be well-behaved, leashed at all times, may not be left alone in the tent or on the site.**

7. **CAMPFIRES:** permitted in designated firepits only. Do not leave unattended. No Fireworks/crackers allowed.

No smoking, cooking or eating permitted inside the tipis or trapper's tents at any time.

8. **VALUABLES:** keep locked in the trunk of your vehicle. **BEDS** must remain in the tents: please leave arranged as found.

9. **VISITORS:** must leave the property **by 11 pm..** Visitors are your responsibility; stay-overs must be approved & signed in.

10. **THIS IS BEAR COUNTRY**

- **Store in a closed hard-sided vehicle when not in use & at night:** all food & all coolers, beverage containers (empty & full), garbage & any items with a strong odour such as toiletries, candles, pet food. It is illegal not to do so. No garbage in firepits or on the site. Items may be removed for your safety & that of other campers & fines levied by Parks Conservation Officers. **Report Bear Sightings to 403.591.7755**
- **The above attractants are NOT allowed inside your tent at any time – only plain water.**
- **Put all waste food, litter & garbage in sealed GARBAGE BAGS – these must go into the BEAR-PROOF BINS.**

11. **WASHING DISHES** No central washing station so **ONLY at your campsite/ NOT at the Water Wells or in Washroom Sinks.**

- Wipe food scraps off dishes & hardened grease into garbage bags - dishes should be as clean as possible; then wash dishes.
- Gray water (containing no food scraps/grease) – may be thrown over a wide area in the bushes.
- Put down flush toilets only if unable to strain out food/grease. Do NOT put food/grease in outdoor toilets!

12. **CHECK-OUT TIME:** 11 am for tipis & trappers' tents | 12 noon for campsites.

HEATERS & LANTERS IN TIPIS AND TRAPPER'S TENTS

Follow instructions posted inside; not those on the heater. If any problems: **TURN OFF!**

Damages resulting from not following the instructions correctly are the responsibility of the camper.

- **Practice lighting your heater & lantern on arrival. Office help is only available if you request it before closing time.**
- Heater refueling by staff occurs once each afternoon so they will NOT be returning at a later time.
- Turn the heater / lantern OFF when you leave the site. Damage to the lantern GLASS - subject to \$ 10.00 charge.
- **Trapper's Tent Windows - always leave partially open for ventilation when the heater / lantern is running.**

Tipis are an Adventure! When it's raining, use the "drip trick" (old native trick):

Tipis naturally shed water down the inside of their poles. If the water hits a knot in the wood, it may start to drip so there may be some drips on the beds when you go in. To **retract the drip** over the knot & down the pole again:

- **Lick your finger and rub the knot on the pole up & down several times; then drag your finger down the pole 8-10". This should retract the drip over the knot (surface tension).**
- If you can't reach the knot, try using a twig or....hey, just move your bed (but leave a 3' clearance for the heater).
- Do not remove the raincatcher near the top or the ozan hanging beneath it (the ozan helps to catch stray drips).

INFO FOR ALL CAMPERS

Emergency Calls for police / ambulance / fire) - DIAL 911

- Failure to abide by these rules may result in eviction without refund; please inform members of your group.
- Trails along the river are not supervised; river banks are undercut in places – extreme caution required.
- If you do not want your name/site number given out to visitors asking for you, you must notify the office at check-in.
- Sites unoccupied for more than 24 hours are considered vacant unless the office is notified of your absence beforehand.

Trading Post Washrooms are closed for cleaning every day after lunch (outhouses are always open).
