## USA SOFTBALL-Oklahoma is proud to present the Sooner State Super Series

USA Softball of Oklahoma is offering a Men's Slow-pitch tournament series. The **Sooner State Super Series** will give sanctioned teams the opportunity to earn points by participating in any or all of a series of tournaments. Points earned over the course of the series will grant the "Points Champions" the opportunity to select their choice of award/merchandise up to a certain value, depending on the division of play.

**Goal/Desire:** To develop a competitive, consistent and sustainable tournament series for sanctioned Men's slow-pitch teams in Oklahoma, which will contribute to the growth and development of the game of softball and to softball in Oklahoma in general. Every effort will be made to ensure a fair, competitive tournament series for all levels of men's slow-pitch.

**Schedule of tournaments:** The series schedule will be posted on the state webpage, [www.usasoftballoklahoma.org](http://www.usasoftballoklahoma.org) and on [www.tournamentusasoftball.com](http://www.tournamentusasoftball.com). Results from each tournament and the points update, will be posted on the state webpage as soon as possible after each event.

This year's tournaments are located in: Lawton, Tahlequah, Enid, Ardmore, Weatherford and Norman.

**Format:** The format for each event will be determined by the tournament host, however each tournament must use an official USA Softball tournament bracket. Either a single-elimination, double-elimination or a three-game guarantee bracket may be used. Bracketing will be done at the discretion of each tournament director. Points will be awarded based on where a team finishes in the bracket.

**Rules:** All teams must be currently registered with the USA Softball of Oklahoma association. The playing rules for each tournament will be in accordance with USA Softball Oklahoma Championship rules. However, tournaments may adjust/alter these guidelines for the good of their event. Any individual tournament rules, will be posted, by the tournament site, in advance to allow teams/players to adapt.

**Rosters:** The USA Softball Official Championship Roster **will not** be used for any series event. Tournament points will be awarded to the person listed as the coach on the team's current year's "Team Member" card and will follow this individual throughout the series.

### **Uniforms:**

Uniforms- jerseys shall be similar in color with a minimum 6" Arabic number in a contrasting color on the back. Caps are not required but if worn they must be worn properly.

### **Equipment:**

Bats-Any legal association stamped bat, is eligible for use in the series. Exception; any bat on the USA Softball non-approved bat lists nor any Senior League bats **will not** be allowed.

Softballs-The ASA Worth Hot Dot-52 cor., 300 com., will be the only softball used in each event. Teams should turn in 4 approved softballs to the tournament director of each tournament before their 1<sup>st</sup> game. These softballs will be used throughout the tournament and will not be returned to the team upon elimination.

**Tournament Awards:** Each tournament will provide their own award package for teams winning/placing in their event.

**Series Awards:** At the conclusion of the tournament series, teams will be given their choice of awards. The choices may include equipment, clothing, reimbursement of state and/or national entry fees or cash. The amount of the award will depend on the team placement and the division of play. A portion of each team's entry fee, from each tournament, will build a "**Team Award Fund.**" This fund will be used for the series awards.

**Points:** Points for each event, will be determined by the number of teams entered in each individual tournament.

25 points x the number of teams entered, i.e.; 25 (points) x 16 (teams) = 400  
Points will decrease by 10 for each place following the tournament champion.

16 teams...Tournament Champion receives 400	
2 <sup>nd</sup> place = 390	3 <sup>rd</sup> place = 380
4 <sup>th</sup> place = 370	5 <sup>th</sup> & 6 <sup>th</sup> place = 355
7 <sup>th</sup> & 8 <sup>th</sup> place = 335	9 <sup>th</sup> – 12 <sup>th</sup> place = 305
13 <sup>th</sup> – 16 <sup>th</sup> place = 265	

Teams will also receive bonus points by entering multiple tournaments.

2 tournaments receive.....	10 points
4 tournaments receive.....	25 points
All 6 tournaments receive ...	50 points

**To be eligible for the end of series prizes, they must compete in a minimum of three (3) series events.**
