Montelupone

Among the many hills of the Marche Region, we find Montelupone, a small village in which melt history art and traditions. It's an ideal place for the "en plein air" tourism lover, thank you to the green areas and the walks among nature. To be seen the Old Town, that preserves the ancient wall, **Palazzo delle Podestà**, the **Historic Theatry "Nicola degli Angeli"**, the **monumental church of San Francesco** and the **Romanque Abbey of San Firmano**. Corinaldo

Corinaldo, small village located on the top of a hill, is still be defended by an intact ring of walls which are dating 1367. The Old Town is unique and evocative in its genre and preserves a lot of Baroque and Neoclassical monuments. Among them, it's recommended to visit the **Piaggia** and the **Pozzo della Polenta**, as well as the **archeological site** and the **Antiquarium di Madonna del Piano**. As regards the gastronomy, the Corinaldo's territory claims the production of extra virgin olive oil, honey and cheeses. [READ MORE](#)



San Ginesio

Blue backgrounds of the Sibillini Mountains, stands the large hill which hosts the ancient town of San Ginesio; between the Town and the Adriatic see wind hills and typical landscapes of the Marche Region. San Ginesio, whose past is narrated in several books from the '500, is witness of sacred and profane, devotion and theatre, artistic vocation and pride commoner. Among the places to visit, is important to mention the **Pieve Collegiata**, the **Ospedale dei Pellegrini**, the **Palio della Pecca**, the **Palio of San Ginesio**, the **National Park of the Sibillini Mountains**. Camerino

Located in the middle of the mountain area of the Macerata province, in the heart of Marche Region, the city of Camerino dominates from the top of the hill the great basin. This small village claims natural beauties, artistic monuments, among which **Piazza Cavour**, **Palazzo Arcivescovile** and **Palazzo Ducale**, venue of one of the most prestigious Italian University since Middle Ages and a lot of culinary delights.

Mondavio is a small village dating Middle Ages and Renaissance, miraculously preserved from disfigurements, triumph of old terracotta and flints. Among the different attractions should be cited La Rocca, builded between 1482 and 1492, inside which now there are set, now, different museums and exhibitions.
