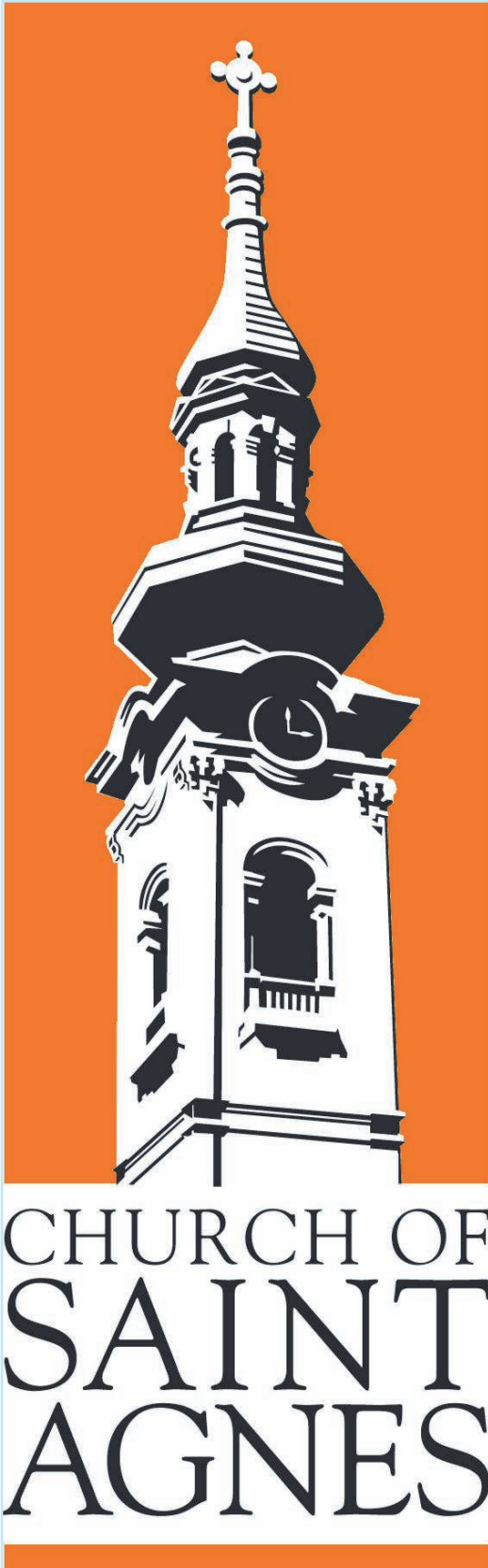

Sacramental Preparation/Requirements for 2017-18

Whereas parents are the primary educators of a child in the Catholic Faith, Saint Agnes offers additional catechetical opportunities for those children preparing to receive First Confession, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.

There are no changes being made to the requirements from last year. Your child will fall into one of these three categories: registered at Saint Agnes School, registered in Family Catechesis*, or Homeschooled. Each of these categories has its own requirements. There is a detailed explanation of these requirements, including all of the important dates, on the parish website: www.churchofsaintagnes.org/sacramental-prep/. 2017-18 Family Catechesis - Registration Begins August 1

Registration for the 2017-18 Family Catechesis program begins August 1 and will continue through September 12.

Classes this year will be on the second Wednesday of each month in Schuler Hall, but will begin at 6:30 pm instead of 6:45 pm. Classes will end by 8:15 pm.

Dates: September 13, October 11, November 8, December 13, January 10, February 14 (Ash Wednesday), March 14, April 11, and May 9.

Tuition: \$40 per student with an \$80 maximum per family (includes books and supplies).

COMING SOON AT SAINT AGNES

Registration Opens August 7 - Saint Agnes Children's Choir

The mission of the Saint Agnes Parish Children's Choir is to sing sacred music that supports and enhances the Liturgy of the Mass. The singers work to develop vocal skills and musicianship through the art of sacred choral music. The mastery of these skills enables the singer to develop discipline, self-confidence and most importantly, a deeper understanding of the Faith.

The repertoire of the choir includes various settings of the Ordinary of the Mass in Latin and English, psalm settings, hymns, and sacred anthems appropriate to the season.

Singers must be between the ages of 9 (3rd grade) and 16 (sophomore), with unchanged voices and have a desire to praise God through sacred song. Although there is no formal audition, the singer must be able to match pitch.

NOTE: If enough boys with changed voices express interest in this group, it may be possible to form a small group (Schola) to prepare some music separately. More information to come on this.
