#### PASTOR'S COLUMN

#### Weekly Children's Holy Hour

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"Then little children were being brought to him in order that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples spoke sternly to those who brought them; but Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs.' And he laid his hands on them and went on his way."

~Matthew 19: 13-15

I am very pleased to announce that thanks to the efforts and organization of two of our parishioners, Saint Agnes is introducing a weekly Children's Holy Hour. As Jesus welcomed the little ones to come to Him in the above Gospel passage, I urge parents of young children to bring them to our Lord present in the Holy Eucharist.

Parents, you may be thinking whether it is truly appropriate to bring small children before the Blessed Sacrament, because they will likely make noise and move about. Do not fear that these childish disruptions are distasteful to the Lord. He knows the hearts and minds of these little ones just as He knows those of adults. He wants them there in His presence learning how to pray and love Him.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church says the following (*emphasis mine*):

"Education in the faith by the parents should begin in the child's <u>earliest years</u>. This already happens when family members help one another to grow in faith by the witness of a Christian life in keeping with the Gospel. Family catechesis precedes, accompanies and enriches other forms of instruction in the faith. <u>Parents have the mission of teaching their children to pray and to discover their vocation</u> as children of God."

Catholic families are called to live prayerful lives, and Catholic parents are bound to teach their children to pray. Regular visits to the Blessed Sacrament, wherein young children are taught to adore our Lord, ask forgiveness for sin, petition Him for help, and thank Him for His Blessings provide a firm foundation around which a truly prayerful life can begin.

Children's Holy Hours will be held every Friday from 11:00 am—Noon beginning July 13. The Holy Hours will take place in the Chapel as part of the weekly Friday Adoration that begins with Exposition after the 8:00 am Mass and ends with Benediction at 5:00 pm. Children's Holy Hours will be cancelled on all Fridays when regular Adoration is cancelled. Cancellations will be published in the bulletin. The Children's Holy Hour will be followed by an opportunity for lunch (bring your own) and fellowship for families in Schuler Hall.
