What is a Tide Captain?

A Tide Captain is a self-appointed 'team leader' for Catch the King. They help recruit and manage volunteers, lead practice mapping sessions in their region, and serve as a point of contact for their mapping team - before, during, and after the event. Experienced Tide Captains also receive access to more functions of the app.



What resources should I use as a Tide Captain?

Tide Captains should be familiar with the following websites and tools to help them with training, practice events, and organizing mappers for Catch the King:

- <u>Wetlands Watch App FAQ Page</u> a hub for all of your Catch the King/app questions and resources including training resources, how-to guides, mapping locations, and more.
- NOAA Tide Prediction Sites explore the map to view tide predictions at certain times and dates near you, and determine your region's window for high tide mapping.
- <u>Sea Rising Solutions Web Portal</u> access your regions and events on the Sea Level Rise app's web portal! You can use the Wiki or email functions to connect with your team.
