## Letters of Interest

## \*Letters of Interest submitted to the NCCF Community Grants Program must include the following:

- 1. Contact information including email address and mailing address.
- 2. Specific amount of funding being requested
- 3. Brief Project Description
- 4. Approximate number of people of who will be impacted by the proposed project.

**Please note:** At any given time, an organization can have only one grant open and can receive only one competitive grant per year. The failure of an applicant to properly close out a grant in a timely manner will be a factor when considering future grant requests.
