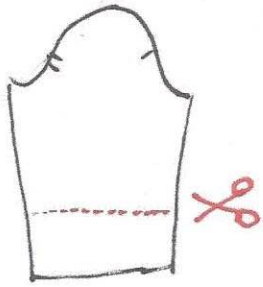
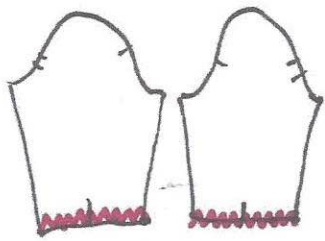


🌿 Lakes Makerie Bell Sleeve Pattern Hack ^{NT}★

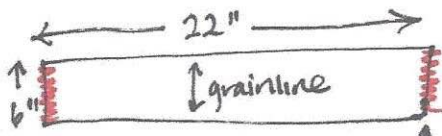


Trace off sleeve pattern piece.
Shorten so bottom of sleeve hits just below elbow (or to desired length)

For my example using Esmé pattern from Lotta Jansdoller's book, this meant cutting off 6 inches



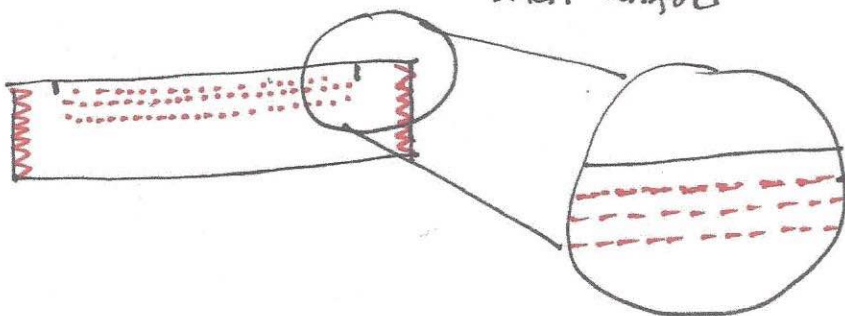
Cut out sleeves, matching patterns if necessary. Finish bottom edge with zig-zag or serger. Attach to completed bodice per pattern instructions



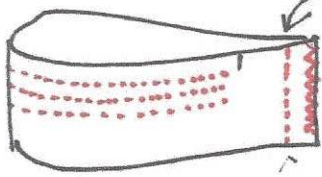
Cut 2 ruffle pieces.
(this is a 6" strip of the width of 44-45" fabric)
finish edges



Mark center and 3 1/2" in from end on both sides using disappearing mark.
fold lower edge 1/4", then 1/4" again. Press well, then unfold

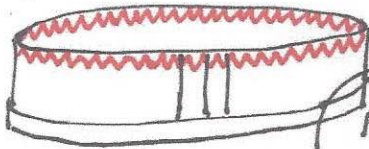


Sew 3 rows of 5-6mm gathering
1/4", 1/2", 5/8" from edge
leave tails long!

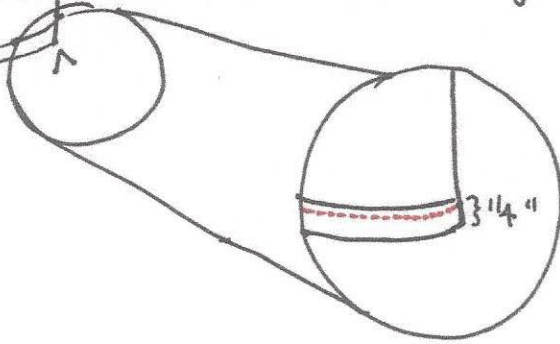


Sew ends together with $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance

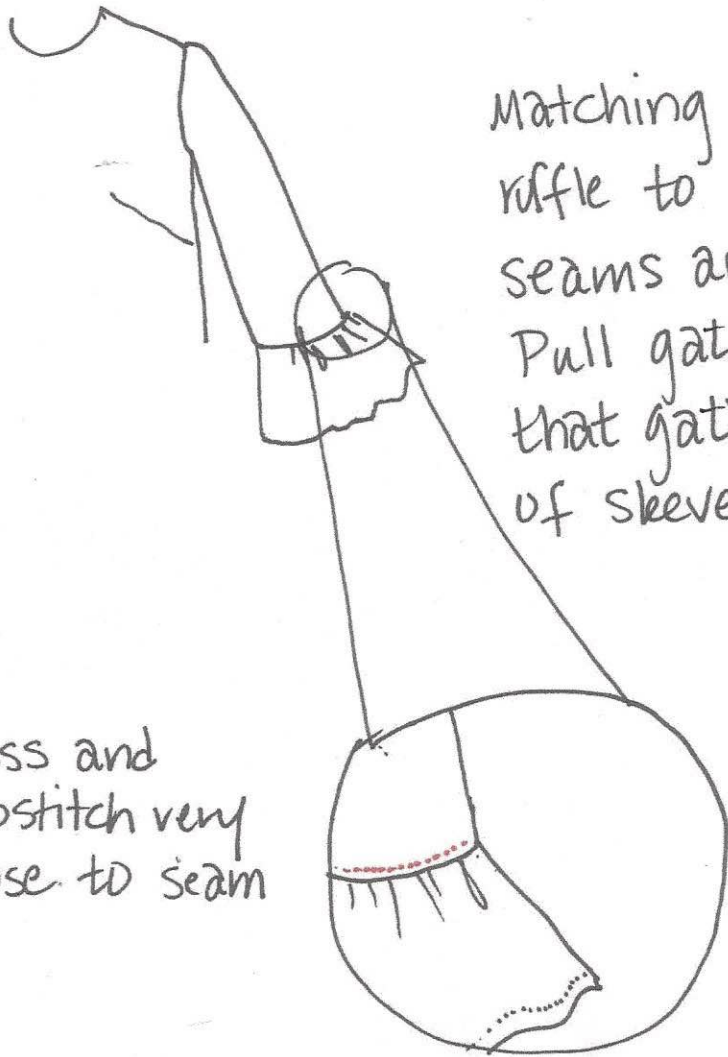
Press seam open



finish upper edge



refold hem edge and stitch in place very close to folded edge.



Matching right sides pin ruffle to sleeve bottom matching seams and centers.

Pull gathering and adjust so that gathers are on outer part of sleeve ruffle

Press and topstitch very close to seam
