Each member of our team will begin their internship with a discussion of goals and a plan to accomplish concrete projects during their time with the campaign. Interns will develop valuable skills in political writing, new media, event planning, and grassroots organizing.

- Draft press release and campaign email blasts
- Research current issues in the race and prepare recommendations
- Build out the campaigns' social media presence
