Student Supply List

- Knitting needles size 4mm or 4.5 mm for knitting swatches and small projects. Recommend 24" circular however students may choose 10" or shorter straights in steel or wood.
- Knitting needles size 3.25 mm for knitting sampler scarf. Recommend 24" circular however students may choose 10" or shorter straights in steel or wood.
- Crochet hook size approx 2.5mm to 3.5 mm for picking up potential dropped stitches.
- Cable needle or single double pointed needle
- Maiwa Supply carries a knitting tool called a Needle Hook. This may be used as a substitute for the three items above (cable needle, double pointed needle and crochet hook).
- Stitch markers; 10 total will be adequate. (Suggest Merchant and Mills bulb pins or Clover brand stitch markers as these are both little safety pins and can be moved easily by simply un-pinning and re-pinning them.)
- Ruler – 6" for measuring knitting gauge
- Scissors – small for cutting yarn
- Knitting needle gauge
- Tapestry needle – sharp and/or blunt
- Notebook
- Pen and/or pencil
