PATTERNS

Students may choose a commercial or self-drafted pattern of their choice. Please ensure pattern is ready to use by workshop. Ideal garments are a top, blouse, vest, skirt or dress. Try to pick a pattern with no more than 8 pattern pieces. You are only sewing one garment in this workshop. Please choose a pattern with at least 2-3 of the following elements.

- Darts, pleats, tucks, and/or gathers
- Button holes, fabric/thread loops
- Fasteners: zippers, snaps, hook and eyes
- Lacework
- Pockets
- Inset corners, curved seams

FABRIC

Students are encouraged to work with the following fabrics. Do not cut fabric before workshop.

- Silk
- Linen
- Chiffon
- Lace
- Velvet
- Wool
- Cotton

Please bring your personal sewing kit and remember to label all your tools. A basic Sewing Kit should include the following:

- Fabric scissors
 - Pins
 - Marking tool (chalk, disappearing ink pen, etc.)
 - Measuring tape/ruler
 - Thread scissors
 - Seam ripper
 - Pen or pencil to write notes
- Any other favorite tools you would like to use
