## **Student Supply List:**

The instructor encourages you to bring your own **domestic sewing machine in good working order** so that you are familiar with its workings. Bring all attachments (including the power cord!). Machines can be left at the studio for the duration of the workshop. We will not need them until the 3rd or 4th class.

If you do not have a machine, we can provide one if you notify us in advance. We have a limited number of machines and these will be assigned on a first come first served basis.

## **Other items for students to bring:**

- 0.5 HB mechanical pencil
- Eraser
- Measuring tape
- Matte finish tape (each to write on)
- Calculator
- Notebook
- Basic sewing supplies to sew toile (thread, scissors, etc)
- Black marker

On the first day students will need to wear fitted clothes for measuring. Sheila recommends a fitted tank or t-shirt and work out shorts or pants.
