Students need to bring

- 1 kg unbleached, undyed, white merino wool sliver/roving
(may be purchased at Maiwa Supply - let the staff at Maiwa Supply know you are in the workshop and you will receive a 20% discount)
- additional natural fibres in sliver/roving form if desired (silk, flax, hemp)
- needles, pins (those bent safety pins that quilters use are good)
- scissors
- pencils and a graphite stick
- old natural fibre garments that are too distressed to be remade into 'new' clothes
- an extra shirt that can be torn up for making string
- bags of gathered threads, small scraps, serger trims, lace, moth-eaten sweaters and so on
- odd short lengths of cloth you may have lying about
(natural colours best, but some pre-used black cloth will also be very useful)
- a small bamboo mat for felting (a sushi mat is perfect)
- three lengths of wooden dowelling (or can be copper/brass pipe if you like) 2 cm to 5 cm in diameter by about 30 cm long
- undyed threads and yarns for stitching : bring a range including cotton, silk, wool, linen
- a drawing pad of paper (of a size that can fit in a suitcase) preferably recycled
- a notebook and the implements you like to use for drawing
- treasured beads and buttons if you like

Please bring a bag lunch and label all of the tools you bring with you.
