Students are required to purchase a commercial pattern of their choice with corresponding materials for class. Try to pick commercial pattern with two to three of the following elements:

- Darts/ Pleats, Gathers
- Decorative edging and embellishments
- Button hole/loops
- Fastenings (zippers, snaps, hook and eyes)
- Lace work
- Pockets
- Inset corners/curves

Remember this is probably the first time you are fully hand sewing a garment. I suggest a simple garment like a top, blouse, vest, skirt or dress. These types of garments do not have a high number of paper pattern parts. Keep the number of paper pattern pieces five or under. You will only be sewing one garment in this course.

Students are encouraged to work with the following fabrics: *Do not cut fabric before workshop*

- Silk
- Linen
- Chiffon
- Satin
- Lace
- Velvet
- Wool
- Cotton

Please bring your personal sewing kit and remember to label all your tools. A basic **Sewing Kit should include** the following:

- Fabric scissors
- Pins
- Marking tool (chalk, disappearing ink pen, etc.)
- Measuring tape/ruler
- Thread scissors
- Seam ripper
- Pen or pencil to write notes
- Any other favorite tools you would like to use
