- Scissors and some of your favorite stitching material.
 - A small mirror
 - Portraits you would like to include in your work (please, have them printed on 8 1/2" X 11" paper from your home printer as that will be easier to work with).
- Keep in mind that you can choose to do one larger (self)portrait or a group portrait of several persons.

Optional:

- Camera to keep track of your working process.
- An embroidery hoop if you like to use one in a size of your choosing.

You are welcome to bring images of your (recent) work, as Tilleke loves to see what you make as it helps her to respond to your work. It may be fun to share some images with the other students. Do keep in mind the images should be **easy to handle** (pictures on your mobile phone won't work in class) In consideration of time limits please bring no more than 3 images.
