Student Supply List:

The Maiwa Studios are well stocked work spaces. For this workshop Maiwa supplies all materials including pima cotton (PFD) yardage, a range of Procion MX dyes and all other supplies for dyeing. If you do not have something that is on Carol's list it is likely we have it in the studio.

The instructor has asked that students bring:

- * Notebook for note taking and a pen
- * Pencil with a working eraser or a separate eraser
- * Calculator
- * Plexi-glass sheet: 1/8" thick by 11 x 14" or 12 x 12" (available at home centers or local glass shops)
- * Three 6 or 8 oz. squirt bottles to hold your dye supply at your table.
- * 2 plastic clothes hangers
- * 6 wooden or plastic clothespins (without dye on them)
- * 3 rolls of 1/2" wide double-sided tape (total of 20 yards)
- * adhesive lint roller
- * Stapler with extra staples

The following items are optional:

- * samples of your dyed fabric and/or photos of your work
- * some silk, rayon, linen or tencel fabric (PFD--prepared for dyeing recommended)

Note to weavers:

- * Feel free to bring some skeined yarns for dyeing: cotton, linen, rayon, tencel, or silk
