

## **Jesus The Divine Mercy** "I Am Love and Mercy Itself."

Mercy is Love turned towards Sin and Sinner.

"The Church, which is Holy, does not reject sinners; she does not reject us all; she does not reject us because she calls everyone, welcomes them, is open even to those furthest from her; she calls everyone to allow themselves to be enfolded by the Mercy, the Tenderness, and the Forgiveness of the Father," Pope Francis

"Why the Cross? Because Jesus takes upon Himself the evil, the filth, the sin of the world, including the sin of all of us, and He cleanses it; He cleanses it with His Blood, with the Mercy and the

Love of God." Pope Francis

Jesus says: "Write: I am Thrice Holy, and I detest the smallest sin. I cannot love a soul which is stained with sin; but when it repents, there is no limit to My Generosity toward it. My Mercy embraces and justifies it. With My Mercy, I pursue sinners along all their paths, and My Heart rejoices when they return to Me. I forget the bitterness with which they fed My Heart and rejoice at their return. "I Am the Light of the World."

Tell sinners that no one shall escape My Hand; if they run away from My Merciful Heart, they will fall into My Just Hands. Tell sinners that I am always waiting for them, that I listen intently to the beating of their heart... When will it beat for Me? Write, that I am speaking to them through their remorse of conscience, through their failures and sufferings, through thunderstorms, through the voice of the Church. And if they bring all My Graces to naught, I begin to be angry with them, leaving them alone and giving them what they want." (D.1728) Pray Without Ceasing.

Yes, the Church welcomes everyone. But it is important to remember that it welcomes sinners to repentance and conversion; "to allow themselves to be enfolded by the Mercy, the Tenderness, and the Forgiveness of the Father;" - Pope Francis. The Church always calls sinners to live a better life; never to endorse our sins. In respecting our 'free will', Jesus cannot lavish His Love and Graces on us, as He greatly desires to do, if our soul is not in the 'state of grace'. A 'state of grace' is gained by the means God has

given us, i.e. sincere repentance, and the Sacrament of Confession. Sin distorts our perception of God; Confession rectifies it. The True Church cannot condone sin, let alone accommodate or celebrate it. When a soul chooses to embrace sin, rather than strive to eradicate it, sin becomes a destructive force, both within and without. The Church cannot be indifferent to unrepented sin. (Luke.17:3, Col 3:16, Ps. 141:5)

"Be merciful to others, as I am to you; and, when you feel your strength failing, if you come to the Fountain of Mercy to fortify your soul, you will not grow weary on your journey." (D.1486)

A Call to Repentance, Conversion, and Trust in God's Mercy 1. Repent and Believe! - "Love God Above All Else": Ask for forgiveness and humbly receive God's Mercy in the Sacrament of Confession. Obey His Commandments. Praise and Thank Him. Spend time with Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration. "Take not the Name of the Lord Your God in Vain." "Keep Holy the Sabbath Day": Go to Mass, receive Holy Communion in the 'state of grace' and avoid non-essential work on Sunday. Strive to be Holy. Get regular Confession, and weekday Mass when possible. Pray the Chaplet for Sinners, Unbelievers, and the Souls in Purgatory. Let your every thought, word and action be a prayer! 2. Be Merciful! - "Love Your Neighbour as Yourself". Jesus gives Himself to you in the Eucharist to love in you, with you, and by means of you. Bring God's Mercy to others. 3. Trust Blindly in Jesus! God's Graces are dependent on our trust in His Mercy. We trust Jesus, our Saviour, will answer our prayers and forgive our sins; but this is not enough. Jesus wants us to hear Him, heed Him and do what He asks of us, to believe in His Word and live by It. In the Divine Mercy Image, Jesus blesses us and sends us out to spread the Message of Divine Mercy to all Mankind; to proclaim the unfathomable graces promised therein.



"One should think about the truth of their life before God, their feelings, and their thoughts. We should look sincerely to ourselves and to our sin. We must feel a sinner and let ourselves be surprised by God. To receive His Infinite Gift of Mercy, we must see the need, feel our emptiness, our misery. We cannot be arrogant." - Pope Francis

Whoever follows Me will never Walk in Darkness but will have the Light of Life.

*"Miseria and misericordia always go hand in hand;"* - St Augustine. To say *misericordia* is to assume *miseria* - that people are deeply suffering from sin; that sin is real. Misery and Mercy are two sides of the same coin.

"All are welcome in the Church; but not on their terms - on Christ's terms." - Cardinal George, Chicago. It is very important to make this distinction when passing on the message of Divine Mercy. God the Father loves everyone equally but that is not to say He is equally pleased with the behaviour of all his children. He calls sinners to repent!

The Sacrament of Reconciliation- "It is a concrete representation of Mercy. We shall recall that primarily we are not there to be judged. It is true that there is judgment in the Confession, but there is something bigger than judgment that comes into play. It is to stand in front of someone who is acting in persona Christi to welcome you and forgive you. It is the encounter with Mercy." – Pope Frances

"My Child, life on earth is a struggle indeed; a great struggle for My Kingdom. But fear not, because you are not alone. I am always supporting you, so lean on Me as you struggle, fearing nothing. Take the Vessel of Trust and draw from the Fountain of Life – for yourself, but also for other souls, especially such as are distrustful of My Goodness." (D. 1488)





**Good Friday**. At three o'clock, I saw the Lord Jesus, crucified, who looked at me and said; "I Thirst". Then I saw two rays issue from His side, just as they appear in the Image. I then felt in my soul the desire to save souls and to empty myself for the sake of poor sinners. I offered myself, together with the dying Jesus, to the

Eternal Father, for the salvation of the whole world. (D.648)

## If You Believe, Behave Like a Believer.

"At three o'clock implore My Mercy especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, steep yourself in My Passion, particularly in My Abandonment at the Moment of Agony. This is the Hour of Great Mercy for the whole world. In this Hour I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My



Passion. " (D.1320)

The Almighty has done great things for me. Holy is His Name. Lk:490

"As often as you hear the clock strike the Third Hour, immerse yourself completely in My Mercy, adoring and glorifying it; invoke its omnipotence for the whole world, and particularly for poor sinners; for at that moment Mercy was opened wide for every soul. Determined is the Day of Justice, the Day of Divine Wrath. The angels tremble before it. Speak to souls about this Great Mercy while it is still the time for granting Mercy. If you keep silent now, you will be answering for a great number of souls on that terrible day. Fear nothing. Be faithful to the end. I sympathize with you." (D.635) -Mother of God

# **The Vessel of Divine Mercy**

The Image of The Divine Mercy represents the Risen Christ Whose Hands and Feet bear the marks of the Crucifixion.

"In the evening, when I was in my cell, I saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand [was] raised in the gesture of blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From beneath the garment, slightly drawn aside at the breast, there were emanating two large rays, one red, the other pale. In silence, I kept my gaze fixed on the Lord; my soul was struck with awe but also with joy. After a while, Jesus said to me; "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature; "Jesus, I trust in You". I desire that this Image be venerated, first in your chapel, and then throughout the world" (D.47)

"I promise the soul that will venerate this Image will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My Own Glory" (D.48)

"I desire that this Image be displayed in public on the first Sunday after Easter. That Sunday is the Feast of Mercy. Through the Word Incarnate, I make known the bottomless depth of My Mercy."(D.88) One gives freely, yet gains even more; another withholds what is right, only to become poor. Pr 11:24

"The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the Life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My Tender Mercy when My Agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the Wrath of My Father. Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the Just Hand of God shall not lay hold of him." (D.299)



"Not in the beauty of the colour, nor Of the brush lies the greatness of this Image, but in My Grace. (D.313)

"My Gaze from this Image is like My Gaze from the Cross." (D.326)

"My Image is already in your soul." (D.49)

"I am offering people a Vessel with which

they are to keep coming for Graces to the Fountain of Mercy. That Vessel is this Image with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in You." (D.327) "The Graces of My Mercy are drawn by means of one Vessel only, and that is – Trust." (D.1578)

"Already there are many souls who have been drawn to My Love by this Image. My Mercy acts in souls through this Work". (D.1379)

# "I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy."

"I want this Image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the



first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy." (D.49)

"Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment... Oh, how much I am hurt by a soul's distrust! Such a soul professes that I am Holy and Just but does not believe that I Am Mercy and does not trust in My Goodness. Even the devils glorify My Justice but do not believe in My Goodness. My Heart rejoices in this title of Mercy." (D.300)

He has helped His servant Israel, remembering to be merciful Lk 1:54

"I am very surprised that You bid me to talk about this Feast of Mercy, for they tell me that there is already such a feast and so why should I talk about it?"; "And who knows anything about this Feast? No one! Even those who should be proclaiming My Mercy and teaching people about it often do not know about it themselves. That is why I want the Image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it." (D.341)

- as He promised to our Fathers - His Mercy to Abraham and his descendants forever. Lk 1:55

"Do all you possibly can for this work of My Mercy. I desire that My Mercy be worshiped, and I am giving mankind the last hope of salvation; that is, recourse to My Mercy. My Heart rejoices in this Feast." (D.998) Ponder the Path of your Feet;

<u>"I demand the worship of My Mercy through the solemn celebration of the Feast</u> and through the veneration of the Image which is painted. By means of this Image I shall grant many graces to souls. It is to be a reminder of the demands of My Mercy, because even the strongest faith is of no avail without works." (D.742).

"No soul will be justified until it turns with confidence to My Mercy; and this is why the first Sunday after Easter is to be the Feast of Mercy. <u>On that day, priests are to</u> <u>tell everyone about My Great and Unfathomable Mercy</u>" (D.570) Whoever is not against us is for us. Mk 9:40

Souls perish in spite of My Bitter Passion. <u>I am giving them the last hope of</u> salvation, that is, the Feast of My Mercy. If they will not adore My Mercy, they will perish for all eternity. Secretary of My Mercy, write, tell all souls about this great Mercy of Mine, because the Awful Day, the Day of My Justice is near." (D.965)

# **Divine Mercy Sunday**

"My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable Mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners.

On that day the very depths of My Tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the Divine Floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My Mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very Depths of My Most Tender Mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My Love and Mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very Depths of Tenderness. It is My Desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (D.699)

Wake up, and strengthen what remains, which is about to die; for I have found your deeds incomplete in the Sight of My God. Rev 3.2

Our Lord promises the remission of the guilt and the punishment of sins to those who go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on this day. Conditions required: 1. Go to Confession on, or shortly before, Mercy Sunday. (St Faustina went to Confession the Saturday beforehand.) "Tell all souls about My Mercy while there is still time." (DMIMS 848, 965)

2. Attend Mass and receive Holy Communion in the 'state of grace' on the Feast Day.

3. Do Works of Mercy (deeds, words and prayers) on the Feast of Divine Mercy.

Remember what you have received and heard. Keep it, and repent. Rev 3:3

"I demand from you deeds of Mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbours always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse or absolve yourself from it. I am giving you three ways of exercising mercy toward your neighbour: the first - by deed, the second - by word, the third - by prayer. In these three degrees is contained the Fullness of Mercy, and it is an unquestionable proof of love for Me. By this means a soul glorifies and pays reverence to My Mercy. Yes, the First Sunday after Easter is a Feast of Mercy but

there must also be acts of mercy" (D.742)

If therefore you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you. Rev 3:3

"Many souls ... are often worried because

they do not have the material means with which to carry out an act of mercy. Yet spiritual mercy, which requires neither permissions nor storehouses, is much more meritorious and is within the grasp of every soul. If a soul does not exercise mercy somehow or other, it will not obtain My Mercy on the Day of Judgment. Oh, if only souls knew how to gather eternal treasure for themselves, they would not be judged, for they would forestall My Judgment with their mercy" (D.1317)

"Oh, how I love those souls who have complete confidence in Me." (D.294)

# **Confession - The Fountain of My Mercy**

"...when you go to Confession, to this Fountain of My Mercy, the Blood and Water which came forth from My Heart always flows down upon your soul and ennobles it. Every time you go to Confession, immerse yourself entirely in My Mercy, with great trust, so that I may pour the bounty of My Grace upon your soul. When you approach the confessional, know this, that I Myself am waiting there for you. I am only hidden by the priest, but I Myself act in your soul. Here the misery of the soul meets the God of Mercy. Tell souls that from this Fount of Mercy souls draw graces solely with the Vessel of Trust. If their trust is great, there is no limit to My Generosity. The torrents of grace inundate humble souls. The proud remain always in poverty and misery, because My Grace turns away from them to humble souls." (D.1602)

If you love Me you will keep My Commandments. Jn 14:15

"For you, I Am Mercy Itself; therefore, I ask you to offer Me your misery and this very helplessness of yours and, in this way, you will delight My Heart." (D.1775)

"Tell souls not to place within their own hearts obstacles to My Mercy, which so greatly wants to act within them. My Mercy works in all those hearts which open their doors to it. Both the sinner and the righteous person have need of My Mercy. Conversion, as well as perseverance, is a Grace of My Mercy." (D.1577)

"Let souls who are striving for perfection particularly adore My Mercy, because the abundance of graces which I grant them flows from My Mercy. I desire that these souls distinguish themselves by boundless trust in My Mercy. I myself will attend to the sanctification of such souls. I will provide them with everything they will need to attain sanctity. The graces of My Mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is - trust. # The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

## "This prayer will serve to appease My Wrath" (D.476)

Opening Prayer; "You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the Ocean of Mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, Unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelope the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us." (D.84).



In 1933, God gave St Faustina a striking vision of His Mercy. She tells us; "I saw a great radiance and, in the midst of it, God the Father. Between this radiance and the earth, I saw Jesus, nailed to the Cross in such a way that when God wanted to look at the earth, He had to look through the Wounds of Jesus. And I understood that it was for the sake of Jesus that God blesses the earth." (D.60)

## How to say the Chaplet

- 1. Begin with the sign of the Cross, Our Father, Hail Mary & The Apostles Creed.
- On the Our Father Beads say the following; Eternal Father, I offer You the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and the sins of the whole world.
- 3. On the 10 Hail Mary Beads say the following: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
  - (Repeat step 2 & 3 for all remaining decades)
- Conclude with the following prayer (three times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have Mercy on us and on the whole world.

Concluding Prayer: "Eternal God, in whom Mercy is endless and the Treasury of Compassion - inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your Mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy Will, which is Love and Mercy Itself." (D.950)

"The souls that say this Chaplet will be embraced by My Mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death." (D.754)

If the Lord is God, follow Him. 1K 18:21

"When they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the Merciful Saviour." (D.1541) "At the hour of their death, I defend as My Own Glory every soul that will say this Chaplet; or <u>when others say it for a dying person, the pardon is the same</u>. When this Chaplet is said by the bedside of a dying person, God's Anger is placated, Unfathomable Mercy envelops the soul, and the very depths of My Tender Mercy are moved for the sake of the Sorrowful Passion of My Son." (D.811)

# Novena of Chaplets for the Feast of Mercy.

"The Lord told me to say this Chaplet for nine days before the Feast of Mercy. It is to begin on Good Friday. **By this** novena, I will grant every possible grace to souls." (D.796) "I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the Fountain of My Mercy, that they may draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever grace they need in the hardships of life, and especially at the hour of death. On each day you will bring to My Heart a different group of souls, and you will immerse them in this Ocean of My Mercy, and I will bring all these souls into the House of My Father. You will do this in this life and in the next. I will deny nothing to any soul whom you will bring to the Fount of My Mercy. Each day you will beg My Father, on the strength of My Bitter Passion, for graces for these souls." (D.1209)

- 1. Today bring to Me all mankind, especially all sinners.
- 2. Today bring to Me the souls of priests and religious.
- 3. Today bring to Me all devout and faithful souls,
- 4. Today bring to Me the pagans and those who do not yet know Me.
- 5. Today bring to Me the souls of those who have separated themselves from My Church.
- 6. Today bring to Me the meek and humble souls and the souls of little children.
- 7. Today bring to Me the souls who especially venerate and glorify My Mercy.
- 8. Today bring to Me the souls who are in the prison of Purgatory.
- 9. Today bring to Me souls who have become lukewarm. (D.1210-228)

## "I have need of your sufferings to rescue souls." (D.1612)

The Lord said; "I suffer even greater pain than that which you see." Jesus [told me] for what sins He subjected Himself to the scourging; these are 'sins of impurity'. Oh, how dreadful was Jesus' moral suffering during the scourging! Then Jesus said to me; "Look and see the human race in its present condition..." Jesus gave me to know in detail the gravity of the malice of the ungrateful souls: "You see, this is a torture greater than My death." (D.445) ... "Those who are like Me, in the pain and contempt they suffer, will be like Me also in glory." (D.446)

## I Turn to You, You - Chosen Souls (D.367)

"My Heart overflows with great Mercy for souls, and especially for poor sinners. And the more perfect a soul is, the stronger and the more far-reaching is the light shed by it. Sooner would heaven and earth turn into nothingness than would My Mercy not embrace a trusting soul."

"My daughter, help Me to save a certain dying sinner. Say the Chaplet that I have taught you for him." When I began to say the Chaplet, I saw the man dying in the midst of terrible torment and struggle. His Guardian Angel was defending him, but he was as it were, powerless against the enormity of the soul's misery. A multitude of devils was waiting for the soul. But while I was saying the Chaplet, I saw Jesus just as He is depicted in the Image. The rays which issued from Jesus' Heart enveloped the sick man, and the powers of darkness fled in panic. The sick man peacefully breathed his last. When I came to myself, I understood how very important the Chaplet was for the dying. It appeases the Anger of God."(D.1565)

# **The Divine Will**

"Know that it will cost you much, so write these words on a clean sheet of paper: "From today on, my own will does not exist," and then cross out the page. And on the other side write these words: "From today on, I do the Will of God everywhere, always, and in everything." Be afraid of nothing; love will give you strength and make the realization of this

easy."(D.372)

Take up the full Armor of God, so that when the Day of Evil comes, you will be able to Stand your Ground. Eph 6:15

You give Me most glory by patiently submitting to My Will, and you win for yourself greater merit than that which any fast or mortification could ever gain for you. Know, ... that if you submit your will to Mine, you draw upon yourself My special Delight. This sacrifice is pleasing to Me and full of sweetness. I take great pleasure in it; there is power in it."<sup>(D.904)</sup>



Be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. Eph 6:10-18

"My Delight is to unite Myself with you. It is when you submit yourself to My Will that you give Me the greatest glory and draw upon yourself a sea of blessings. I would not take such special delight in you if you were not living by My Will. Know, My daughter, that the entire Holy Trinity finds Its special Delight in you, because you live exclusively by the Will of God. No sacrifice can compare with this." (D.954-955)

When once I asked the Lord Jesus how He could tolerate so many sins and crimes and not punish them, the Lord answered me; "I have eternity for punishing [these], and so I am prolonging the Time of Mercy for the sake of [sinners]. But woe to them if they do not recognize this Time of My Visitation. My daughter, secretary of My Mercy, your duty is not only to write about and proclaim My Mercy, but also to beg for this grace for them, so that they too may glorify My Mercy." (D.1160)

"I want the eyes of your soul to be always firmly and truly fixed on My Holy Will. Since it is in this way that you will please Me most. No sacrifice can compare to this." (D.1327)

"My Child, know that the greatest obstacles to holiness are discouragement and an exaggerated anxiety. These will deprive you of the ability to practice virtue. All temptations united together ought not disturb your interior peace, not even momentarily. Sensitiveness and discouragement are the fruits of self-love. You should not become discouraged, but strive to make My Love reign in place of your self-love. Have confidence, My Child. Do not lose heart in coming for pardon, for I am always ready to forgive you. As often as you beg for it, you glorify My Mercy." (D.1488)

"Outwardly your sacrifice should look like this: silent, hidden, permeated with love, imbued with prayer. I demand that your sacrifice be pure and full of humility, that I might find pleasure Be holy for I, the Lord your God, Am Holy.

"I need sacrifice lovingly accomplished, because that alone has meaning for Me. Enormous indeed are the debts of the world which are due to Me; pure souls can pay them by their sacrifice, exercising mercy in spirit." (D.1316)


"This firm resolution to become a saint is extremely pleasing to Me. I bless your efforts and will give you opportunities to sanctify yourself. Be watchful that you lose no opportunity that My Providence offers you for sanctification. If you do not succeed in taking advantage of an opportunity, do not lose your peace, but humble yourself profoundly before Me and, with great trust, immerse yourself completely in My Mercy. In this way, you will gain more than you have lost, because more favour is granted to a humble soul than the soul itself asks for." (D.1361)

"My daughter, your compassion for Me refreshes Me. By meditating on My Passion, your soul acquires a distinct beauty." (D.1657)

"If you did not tie My Hands, I would send down many punishments upon the earth. My daughter, your look disarms My Anger. Although your lips are silent, you call out to Me so mightily that all heaven is moved. I cannot escape from your requests, because you pursue Me, not from afar but within your own heart." (D.1722)

"Today consider My Sorrowful Passion in all its immensity. Consider it as if it had been undertaken for your sake alone." (D.1761) Have great love for those who cause you suffering. Do good to those who hate you." (D.1628)

"Pray for souls that they be not afraid to approach the Tribunal of My Mercy [the Sacrament of Penance]. Do not grow weary of praying for sinners. You know what a burden their souls are to My Heart. Relieve My Deathly Sorrow; dispense My Mercy." (D.975)



# **Spiritual Warfare**

"First, do not fight against a temptation by yourself, but disclose it to the confessor at once, and then the temptation will lose all its force. Second, during these ordeals do not lose your peace; live in My Presence; ask My Mother and the Saints for help. Third, have the certitude that I am looking at you and supporting you. Fourth, do not fear either struggles of the soul or any temptations, because I am supporting you; if only you are willing to fight, know that the victory is always on your side. Fifth, know that by fighting bravely you give Me great glory and amass merits for yourself. Temptation gives you a chance to show Me your fidelity." Do not act out of selfish ambition or be conceited. Pp 2:3

"You should not worry too much about adversities. The world is not as powerful as it seems to be; its strength is strictly limited. Know, that if your soul is filled with the fire of My Pure Love, then all difficulties dissipate like fog before the sun's rays and dare not touch the soul. All adversaries are afraid to start a quarrel with such a soul, because they sense that it is stronger than the whole world."<sup>(D.1643)</sup> My Sheep listen to

"Only do as much as you can, and I will always arrange things so that you will easily be able to do what I ask of you." (D.1693)

"My daughter, I want to teach you about spiritual warfare. Never trust in yourself, but abandon yourself totally to My Will. In desolation, darkness and various doubts, have recourse to Me and to your spiritual director. He will always answer you in My Name. Do not bargain with any temptation; lock yourself immediately in My Heart and, at the first opportunity, reveal the temptation to the confessor. Put your selflove in the last place, so that it does not taint your deeds. Bear with yourself with great patience. Do not neglect interior mortifications. Always justify to yourself the opinions of your superiors and of your confessor. Shun murmurers like a plague. Let

all act as they like; you are to act as I want you to." (D.1760)

"Observe the rule as faithfully as you can. If someone causes you trouble, think what good you can do for the person who caused you to suffer. Do not pour out your feelings. Be silent when you are rebuked. Do not ask everyone's opinion, but only the opinion of your confessor; be as frank and simple as a child with him. Do not become discouraged by ingratitude. Do not examine with curiosity the roads down which I lead you. When boredom and discouragement beat against your heart, run away from yourself and hide in My Heart. Do not fear struggle; courage itself often intimidates temptations, and they dare not attack us." (D.1760.)

"Always fight with the deep conviction that I am with you. Do not be guided by feeling, because it is not always under your control; but all merit lies in the Will. Always depend upon your superiors, even in the smallest things. I will not delude you with prospects of peace and consolations; on the contrary, prepare for great battles... Do not be unduly fearful, because you are not alone." (D. 1760)

"Faithfulness to the Inspiration of the Holy Spirit is the shortest route to holiness." (D.291)

"Speak to Me about everything in a completely simple and human way; by this you will give Me great joy. I understand you because I am God-Man. This simple language of your heart is more pleasing to Me than the hymns composed in My Honour. Know, that the simpler your speech is, the more you attract Me to yourself."(D.797) Do not Quench the Spirit

"It should be of no concern to you how anyone else acts; you are to be My living reflection, through love and mercy." "I answered, Lord, but they often take advantage of my goodness." "That makes no difference, My daughter. That is no concern of yours. As for you, be always merciful toward other people, and especially toward sinners." (D.1446)

"Strive to make your heart like unto My Humble and Gentle Heart. Never claim your rights. Bear with great calm and patience everything that befalls you." (D.1701)

> "For you I descended from heaven to earth; for you I allowed Myself to be nailed to the Cross; for you I let My Sacred Heart be pierced with a lance, thus opening wide the Source of Mercy for you. Come, then, with trust to draw Graces from this Fountain." (D.1485)

# Faustina's Vision of Hell, Purgatory and Heaven

"...I saw two roads. One was broad, covered with sand and flowers, full of joy, music and all sorts of pleasures. People walked along it, dancing and enjoying themselves. They reached the end without realizing it. And at the end of the road there was a horrible precipice; that is, the abyss of hell. The souls fell blindly into it; as they walked, so they fell. And their number was so great that it was impossible to count them. And I

saw the other road, or rather, a path, for it was narrow and strewn with thorns and rocks; and the people who walked along it had tears in their eyes, and all kinds of suffering befell them. Some fell down upon the rocks but stood up immediately and went on. At the end of the road there was a magnificent garden filled with all sorts of happiness and all these souls entered there. At the very first instant they forgot all their

sufferings" (D.153)

The hired hand is not the shepherd, and the sheep are not his own. Jn 10

"...How fleeting all earthly things are, and everything that appears great disappears like smoke, and does not give the soul freedom, but weariness. Happy the soul that understands these things and with only one foot touches the earth" (D. 1141)

"...If a soul loves God sincerely and is intimately united with Him, then, even though such a soul may be living in the midst of difficult external circumstances, nothing can disturb its interior life; and in the midst of corruption, it can remain pure and unsullied; because the great love of God gives it strength for battle, and God also protects it in a special way." (D. 1094) When he sees the wolf coming, he abandons the sheep and runs away. Jn 10

"I was led by an Angel to the chasms of hell... I would have died at the very sight of these tortures if the omnipotence of God had not supported me. Let the sinner know that he will be tortured throughout all eternity, in those senses which he made use of to sin... I am writing this at the command of God, so that no soul may find an excuse by saying there is no hell, or that nobody has ever been there, and so no one can say what it is like ...But I noticed one thing: that most of the souls there are those who disbelieved that there is a hell. I could hardly recover from the fright. How terribly souls suffer there!.. Consequently, I pray even more fervently for the conversion of sinners." (D. 741)

## Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. Jn 10

"In a moment I was in a misty place full of fire in which there was a great crowd of suffering souls. They were praying fervently, but to no avail for themselves; only we can come to their aid... their greatest torment was longing for God. I saw Our Lady visiting the souls in Purgatory. The souls call her "The Star of the Sea". She brings them refreshment...Since that time, I am in closer communion with the suffering souls."(D. 20)

## The man runs away because he is a hired hand. Jn 10

"Today I was in heaven, in spirit, and I saw its inconceivable beauties and the happiness that awaits us after death. I saw how all creatures give ceaseless praise and glory to God. I saw how great is happiness in God, which spreads to all creatures, making them happy; and then all the glory and praise which springs from this happiness returns to its source; and they enter into the depths of God, contemplating the inner life of God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, whom they will never comprehend or fathom. This source of happiness is unchanging in its essence, but it is always new, gushing forth happiness for all creatures." (D.777)

The hired worker cares nothing for the sheep. Jn 10

"I rarely have such visions. But I more often commune with the Lord in a more profound manner. My senses sleep and, although not in a visible way, all things become more real and clearer to me than if I saw them with my eyes. My intellect learns more in one moment than during long years of thinking and meditation, both as regards the essence of God and ... revealed truths, also as regards the knowledge of my own misery." (D.882)

## "Know without doubt, and once and for all, that only Mortal Sin drives Me out of a soul, and nothing else. (D.1181)

"Your misery does not hinder My Mercy. My daughter, write that the greater the misery of a soul, the greater its right to My Mercy; [urge] all souls to trust in the Unfathomable Abyss of My Mercy, because I want to save them all. On the Cross, the Fountain of My Mercy was opened wide by the lance for all souls – no one have I excluded." (D. 1182) The Lord is my Shepherd. I shall not want. Ps 23

In the evening, I saw the Lord Jesus upon the cross. From His Hands,

feet, and side the Most Sacred Blood was flowing. After some time, Jesus said to me; "All this is for the salvation of souls. Consider well.. what you are doing for their salvation. I answered; "Jesus, when I look at Your suffering, I see that I am doing next to nothing for the salvation of souls." "Know, that your silent day-to-day martyrdom in complete submission to My Will ushers many souls into heaven. And when it seems to you that your suffering exceeds your strength, contemplate My Wounds, and you will rise above human scorn and judgment. Meditation on My Passion will help you rise above all things." (D.1184)

"From all My Wounds, like from streams, Mercy flows for souls, but the Wound in My Heart is the Fountain of Unfathomable Mercy. From this Fountain spring all Graces for souls. The flames of compassion burn Me. I desire greatly to pour them out upon souls. Speak to the whole world about My Mercy." (D.1190) Jesus, You are Love and Mercy

"The soul that will go to Confession in preparation for this day and receive Holy Communion on the day, shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." (D.699). "The extraordinary grace promised by Jesus in connection with the Feast of Mercy is something greater by far than the plenary indulgence [granted by Pope John Paul II for the Feast of Mercy]. The remarkable grace promised by Our Lord on the Feast of Mercy is very much akin to a 'second baptism'. Now the sacramental grace of Baptism if received by an adult, is not only the removal of Original Sin from the soul, but also the removal of all personal sins committed since birth, and any punishment due to them...

The Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy must be a worthy one.

## I Trust in You

Unworthily received, or not accompanied by trust in the Divine Mercy and by some deed of mercy toward one's neighbour, it would be a contradiction of the Devotion to the Divine Mercy. Instead of the most singular grace, it would draw Divine Wrath upon the head of the recipient. The spiritual good of the Faithful demands that they know what great graces they can obtain by the Holy Communion received on the Feast of Mercy, and under what

conditions they can obtain them." -This analysis, by Canon Rozycki, was approved by Pope John Paul II
