Tania Bruguera surpasses the fundraising limit for her civic project seven days before the close of the campaign

The *crowdfunding* campaign led by artist Tania Bruguera to raise funds for the creation of an Institute for civic literacy in Havana has surpassed the goal of 100,000 dollars that was set at its beginning. Seven days before finalizing the fundraising, the project has already received more than 102, 00o dollars in donations from more than 700 donors around the world

The idea emerged after repressive events experienced during her attempt to take the performance *El susurro de Tatlin* (Tatlin's Whisper) to *Plaza de la Revolución* (Revolution Plaza).

The Hannah Arendt Institute of Artivism (INSTAR) will be open to the participation of international artists and activists who will be able to collaborate with Cubans.
