TASTE GLASS BTL

Nebbiolo, native to Piedmont in northwestern Italy, is one of the world's greatest red grapes. It has complex aromatics, often times described as smelling like "tar and roses", and is rich, robust, structured and full bodied (qualities which make it ideal for warming up on a cold winter's evening). It's top examples: Barolo, Barbaresco and a handful of other sites make some of the most sought after wines in the world. It pairs perfectly with hearty winter cuisine.
