

McNairy County Schools
2017 E-Rate Addendum
March 17th, 2017

According to the RFP, bidders submitting bids were required to attend the walkthrough held on March 9th of this year. A copy of this document will be posted on our website www.mcnairycountyschools.com at the bottom of the home page and on the section labeled Technology Bids. Below we have outlined any changes or specifications made during that walkthrough and questions submitted via email during the past week. Bidders are reminded that all submissions must be submitted by 12:00 noon on March 30th in accordance with directions in the RFP. McNairy County Schools thanks you for your interest in our school system.

1. Bidders should submit a total cost for each project on the price worksheet as well as a breakdown of each portion of the proposed project at each school site.
2. The exterior fiber runs at SES and RES can be run in conduit under the existing awnings.
3. The exterior fiber runs at MCHS and AHS should be quoted as stated in the RFP. Bidders should clearly designate the cost of this particular part of the projects at these two sites.
4. All fibers runs should originate at the MDF.
5. There shall be no exposed cables.
6. No additional site visits shall be permitted between March 9th and March 30th.
7. MCHS theatre drops shall be located in media room opposite stage. Additional drops in questions during walkthrough shall be placed directly behind stage. One drop on each level.
8. The drops in the AHS offices adjacent to the band room can be run to the nearest switch.
9. Exterior drops will be posted on the external wall of common areas and connect to the nearest existing switch.
10. Outdoor AP shall be a minimum 2-Stream Wave-2.
11. Specific quantities of racks are dependent on funding. Bidders need to submit best pricing for unit cost of each listed unit.
12. Licensing fees shall be included in cost of switches and or access points. Meraki 5-year enterprise license or equivalent.
13. Bidders should quote 48 port CAT6 compatible "copper" patch panels.
14. The 2U wall mount brackets need to be able to support single switches or servers as shown in schools during walkthrough.

We will begin bid submission review on or around March 30th. The winning bidder shall be contacted shortly thereafter.
