- I tell you, look up and see the fields ripe for the harvest.
- You may go; your son will live
- Rise, take up your mat, and walk
- Look, you are well; do not sin anymore, so that nothing worse may happen to you
- Do not be amazed at this, because the hour is coming in which all who are in the tombs will hear his voice
- Do not think that I will accuse you before the Father: the one who will accuse you is Moses, in whom you have placed your hope.
- Have the people recline.
- Gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted.”
- It is I. Do not be afraid
- Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him the Father, God, has set his seal
- Stop murmuring among yourselves.
- No one works in secret if he wants to be known publicly. If you do these things, manifest yourself to the world
- You go up to the feast. I am not going up to this feast, because my time has not yet been fulfilled
- Stop judging by appearances, but judge justly
- Let anyone who thirsts come to me and drink
- Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her
- Neither do I condemn you. Go, (and) from now on do not sin any more
- Go wash in the Pool of Siloam
- If I do not perform my Father's works, do not believe me but if I perform them, even if you do not believe me, believe the works, so that you may realize (and understand) that the Father is in me and I am in the Father
- Where have you laid him
- Take away the stone
- Lazarus, come out
- Untie him and let him go
- Leave her alone. Let her keep this for the day of my burial.
- Fear no more, O daughter Zion; see, your king comes, seated upon an ass's colt
- Whoever serves me must follow me, and where I am, there also will my servant be

- I am troubled now. Yet what should I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour?’ But it was for this purpose that I came to this hour.
- Father, glorify your name
- Walk while you have the light, so that darkness may not overcome you. Whoever walks in the dark does not know where he is going.
- While you have the light, believe in the light, so that you may become children of the light
- What you are going to do, do quickly
- Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me
- Have I been with you for so long a time and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father
- Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else, believe because of the works themselves
- Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you.
- Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid.
- Get up, let us go
- but the world must know that I love the Father and that I do just as the Father has commanded me
- Remain in me, as I remain in you
- If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you.
- As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love.
- Remember the word I spoke to you No slave is greater than his master
- Until now you have not asked anything in my name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete.
- In the world you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world.
- Father, the hour has come. Give glory to your son, so that your son may glorify you
- Glorify me, Father, with you, with the glory that I had with you before the world began.
- And now I will no longer be in the world, but they are in the world, while I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are.
- Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth
- I told you that I AM. So if you are looking for me, let these men go
- Put your sword into its scabbard
- Why ask me? Ask those who heard me what I said to them
- If I have spoken wrongly, testify to the wrong; but if I have spoken rightly, why do you strike me
