Matthew 3:2 (NABWRNT)

<sup>2</sup> (and) saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!”

Matthew 4:17 (NABWRNT)

<sup>17</sup> From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

Matthew 11:20 (NABWRNT)

<sup>20</sup> Then he began to reproach the towns where most of his mighty deeds had been done, since they had not repented.

Matthew 11:21 (NABWRNT)

<sup>21</sup> “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty deeds done in your midst had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would long ago have repented in sackcloth and ashes.

Matthew 12:41 (NABWRNT)

<sup>41</sup> At the judgment, the men of Nineveh will arise with this generation and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and there is something greater than Jonah here.

Mark 1:15 (NABWRNT)

<sup>15</sup> “This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

Mark 6:12 (NABWRNT)

<sup>12</sup> So they went off and preached repentance.

Luke 10:13 (NABWRNT)

<sup>13</sup> “Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty deeds done in your midst had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would long ago have repented, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.

Luke 11:32 (NABWRNT)

<sup>32</sup> At the judgment the men of Nineveh will arise with this generation and condemn it, because at the preaching of Jonah they repented, and there is something greater than Jonah here.

Luke 13:3 (NABWRNT)

<sup>3</sup> By no means! But I tell you, if you do not repent, you will all perish as they did!

Luke 13:5 (NABWRNT)

<sup>5</sup> By no means! But I tell you, if you do not repent, you will all perish as they did!”

Luke 15:7 (NABWRNT)

<sup>7</sup> I tell you, in just the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need of repentance.

Luke 15:10 (NABWRNT)

<sup>10</sup> In just the same way, I tell you, there will be rejoicing among the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”

Luke 16:30 (NABWRNT)

<sup>30</sup> He said, ‘Oh no, father Abraham, but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.’

Luke 17:3 (NABWRNT)

<sup>3</sup> Be on your guard! If your brother sins, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him.

Luke 17:4 (NABWRNT)

<sup>4</sup> And if he wrongs you seven times in one day and returns to you seven times saying, 'I am sorry,' you should forgive him."

Acts 2:38 (NABWRNT)

<sup>38</sup> Peter (said) to them, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the holy Spirit.

Acts 3:19 (NABWRNT)

<sup>19</sup> Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away,

Acts 8:22 (NABWRNT)

<sup>22</sup> Repent of this wickedness of yours and pray to the Lord that, if possible, your intention may be forgiven.

Acts 17:30 (NABWRNT)

<sup>30</sup> God has overlooked the times of ignorance, but now he demands that all people everywhere repent

Acts 26:20 (NABWRNT)

<sup>20</sup> On the contrary, first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem and throughout the whole country of Judea, and then to the Gentiles, I preached the need to repent and turn to God, and to do works giving evidence of repentance.

2 Corinthians 12:21 (NABWRNT)

<sup>21</sup> I fear that when I come again my God may humiliate me before you, and I may have to mourn over many of those who sinned earlier and have not repented of the impurity, immorality, and licentiousness they practiced.

Revelation 2:5 (NABWRNT)

<sup>5</sup> Realize how far you have fallen. Repent, and do the works you did at first. Otherwise, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.

Revelation 2:16 (NABWRNT)

<sup>16</sup> Therefore, repent. Otherwise, I will come to you quickly and wage war against them with the sword of my mouth.

Revelation 2:21 (NABWRNT)

<sup>21</sup> I have given her time to repent, but she refuses to repent of her harlotry.

Revelation 2:22 (NABWRNT)

<sup>22</sup> So I will cast her on a sickbed and plunge those who commit adultery with her into intense suffering unless they repent of her works.

Revelation 3:3 (NABWRNT)

<sup>3</sup> Remember then how you accepted and heard; keep it, and repent. If you are not watchful, I will come like a thief, and you will never know at what hour I will come upon you.

Revelation 3:19 (NABWRNT)

<sup>19</sup> Those whom I love, I reprove and chastise. Be earnest, therefore, and repent.

Revelation 9:20 (NABWRNT)

<sup>20</sup> The rest of the human race, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, to give up the worship of demons and idols made from gold, silver, bronze, stone, and wood, which cannot see or hear or walk.

Revelation 9:21 (NABWRNT)

<sup>21</sup> Nor did they repent of their murders, their magic potions, their unchastity, or their robberies.

Revelation 16:9 (NABWRNT)

<sup>9</sup> People were burned by the scorching heat and blasphemed the name of God who had power over these plagues, but they did not repent or give him glory.

Revelation 16:11 (NABWRNT)

<sup>11</sup> and blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and sores. But they did not repent of their works.
