Please keep in mind that our center's mission is to provide services to children whose primary diagnosis is Speech-Language Delay as well as to the underserved children in our community. **We aim to enroll children receiving no or minimal therapy services; not all children will be accepted into camp.** Campers must be at least three years of age by the first day of camp (June 4<sup>th</sup>).

**Applications will be accepted from March 1<sup>st</sup> - April 15<sup>th</sup>.**

Acceptance letters will be sent on May 10<sup>th</sup> regarding acceptance into camp. Camp donations (\$150 suggested donation) to cover your child's camp materials and BBQ are requested by Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup>.

Please do not drop off applications in person as our therapists are in therapy sessions throughout the day and will not be available to help you.

**Immunizations:**

Campers are required to have all immunizations up to date. An Immunization record must be submitted for enrollment in camp.

**Camp Dates:**

**Monday, June 4<sup>th</sup> – Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup>:** Therapy sessions run Mondays – Thursdays between 9am-4:30pm. Your child will attend one 60-minute therapy session per week for 8 weeks. All children must be able to attend at least 6 weeks of camp.

**Reports/Evaluations/IEPs:**

Children are also required to have a recent speech/language evaluation/screening or have an IEP in order to determine eligibility for camp. If your child does not have this, please let us know and we will contact you about scheduling a screening to determine eligibility and group placement.

**Please send your child’s most current IEP with progress notes on current IEP goals from their therapist as well as a speech/language evaluation & immunization records. You can ask the school district/therapist/doctor to mail or email it to us if you do not have a copy. Applications will not be considered complete until these are received (everything must be received by April 15<sup>th</sup> to be considered for camp).**

**Camp expectations:** Our goal is to provide a language-rich camp where your child will work with a peer and therapist targeting individualized goals; therefore, your child should be able to attend a small group session without 1:1 assistance. **If your child requires extra assistance to attend to teacher-directed activities, or to stay with the group and participate in camp, then they are not a candidate for this program.** Children enrolled in SDC (Special Day Class) and children with Spectrum Disorders (Autism, Asperger’s, PPD-NOS) do not benefit from this structured, non-intensive program. These children are better served attending a summer program offered through the school system. We reserve the right to determine if your child is going to be able to participate fully in our program, which will be determined during the first week of camp. If our clinicians conclude that your child is not a fit for this camp, then your camp cost will be fully refunded.

**Camp Cost:**

No family will be turned away due to inability to make the suggested donation. **The minimum suggested donation for camp is \$150**, which will cover expenses for camp and therapy materials, homework packets, child’s camp shirt, & BBQ tickets for 1 adult and 1 child. Any additional donation is greatly appreciated and ensures the longevity of our programs. In order to purchase all necessary materials for camp, we ask that you make your donation by Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, payable by cash or check (made out to **Camp Chit Chat**). **Please do not send money with your application. Once you receive notification of your child’s acceptance into camp, then your donation can be made.**

**Availability**

Please be aware that there will be more than 60 children attending camp each week. We do our best to work with your schedule; however, you may not get the time that you prefer, so please be flexible! Please give us multiple times and days (at least three) that your child is available to attend a therapy session. Please note that the times below aren’t necessarily exact session times as some sessions may begin on the half hour or quarter hour.
