I/we will not take holidays during term time. 2) My/Our daughter wears full and correct uniform to school and had the correct equipment to take part in lessons. 3) I/We will encourage my/our daughter to maintain high standards of behaviour at all times, upholding the ethos of Respect, Opportunity and Achievement and supporting the school in the implementation of the behaviour policy including detentions. 4) My/Our daughter is supported with homework and preparation for examinations and assessments. I/We will check and sign her planner regularly. 5) I/We will attend Parents' evenings and consultation days to discuss my/our daughter's progress with staff. I/We will respond to all correspondence from the school. 6) My/Our daughter participates in the many opportunities provided by the school, including trips, clubs and study sessions. 7) My/Our daughter understands the need to keep the school environment clean, tidy and safe and that I/we will be called upon to pay for any damage or abuse. 8) I/We notify the school immediately of any change to personal circumstances and details, including contact numbers and home address. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Attend school every day and on time. 2) Wear full and correct uniform to school and ensure that I have the correct equipment for every lesson including P.E Kit. 3) Uphold the ethos of Respect, Opportunity and Achievement and comply with the school's behaviour policy including attending any detentions set by staff. 4) Work to the best of my ability in class and participate fully in school life. Complete and hand all homework in on time. I will ensure my planner is used correctly and kept clean and neat. I will ensure my planner is seen and signed regularly by a parent. 5) Keep parents informed of all school activities, parents' evenings, consultation days and information evenings. 6) Be a positive and active member of the school community and take advantage of the many opportunities offered by the school, including trips, clubs and study sessions. 7) Keep the school and its grounds clean, tidy and safe. Set, assess and monitor class and homework, providing the appropriate support. Check pupil planners regularly. 5. Send regular information home about attainment and academic achievement and arrange parents' evenings and consultation days to discuss pupil's progress. 6. Provide a range of extra-curricular activities and encourage student participation, including trips, clubs and study sessions. 7. Provide a safe, clean, well-equipped and attractive learning environment. 8. Respond promptly to student and parent concerns.
