Dear Parent(s)/Guardians,

I hope all of you and your children are doing well. As Dr. Semmel shared in his most recent communication, Hillcrest will be closed to all students through Wednesday September 30th. Students in Cohort B may re-enter the building on Thursday October 1st. This decision was not made lightly, and was the result of careful and thorough contact tracing completed by the Trumbull Nursing Department. We are very grateful for their help and support.

Students will be following the same schedule we use for temporary remote learning. That schedule can be found on the second page of this letter. Teachers will be utilizing Google classroom to provide instruction to your children. The staff is committed to continuing the scope and sequence of their curriculum as we go through this temporary remote learning period together. We ask that students make every effort to log in to their classrooms on time, and to exhibit SOARRing behaviors for remote learning (found on page 3 of this letter).

I will record daily announcements for students and parents to provide guidance and updates on our current situation, and on remote learning. Just as we did in the spring, this will act as our regular communication between the school and your family. I know that many families want our students to receive as much in person instruction as possible. I share that sentiment, and assure you that we are working hard to get our students back in the building as soon as possible. Please let me know if you have any questions.

- -Be in control of your own behavior






