The State of the Plate

A recent article by Jayson D. Bradley, a well-known writer and pastor, quoted a survey from 2014 that *showed 40% of people never write checks anymore and of the remainders, 20% only write checks a couple times a year. But that's not all, almost one in ten people no longer carry cash, and nearly 80% of them never have more than \$50 at any given time. What does that mean as we pass the plate?*

Our giving patterns have changed with technology. At Hawthorne Gospel Church, we have four ways of worshiping through giving. What works for you?

1. Cash or checks in the offering plate or offering envelopes designating the desired ministry or account.
2. On line giving through the church website: www.hawthornegospel.com and clicking on the word **Give** in the top right-hand corner of the home page and then filling out the credit or debit card information.
3. Regular giving through your bank's *Bill Pay* page with just a couple of clicks to set up *automatic payments*.
4. Via U.S. Postal Service mailed to the church office.

Generosity is far more than meeting the church budget or meeting a specific need. It's about how we learn **The Joy of Generosity** as we give faithfully and sacrificially. Generosity is a critical part of our worship and spiritual growth toward being *fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ*. We are to be good stewards of what God has provided for us.
