## The Broad Road



**It was Jesus who said:** *Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it (Matthew 7:13-14).*

**Questions:** Do we really believe those words? Do you believe that the neighbors on your street are on the broad road that leads to destruction? What about your co-workers or family members? What about the millions of people who have never heard even once the good news of how to be rescued? Or are these words of Jesus simply a nice metaphor to read from time to time?

Most of us would not hesitate to take some risk to help a neighbor, friend, or family member who was in physical danger. Many of us would even do that for a stranger! Now, if you really understand that people are in great danger of eternal destruction because they are on the broad road, then shouldn't that move you to share the solution for their rescue? It seems to me that if I truly believe that people are on the road to destruction, then it should drive me to intercede and act on their behalf.
