Don's early years were spent growing up on the mission field in Africa where his parents were AIM missionaries. He returned in 1977 to teach at Rift Valley Academy where he met Gail. At RVA, a school for missionary children, Don was the elementary school principal and he also taught physical education and was the activities director. Gail served as the elementary school librarian. The following is from their June 2016 Newsletter:
