Lifeguarding Class

An American Red Cross Certification Lifeguarding Course
will be held Saturday, June 24th, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM and
Monday, June 26th, through Friday, June 30th, from 1:00 to 6:00 PM
on our campus.

This 30-hour course has the following prerequisites:

- Minimum age of 15 years by the conclusion of the course
- Swim 300 yards continuously
- Tread water two minutes, no hands
- Complete a timed event within 1 minute and 40 seconds
Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. Surface dive to a depth of
7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the
surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting
point. Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.

This course costs \$275. To register or for more information,
