Progress Update December 8, 2017**

Heavy trash/litter locations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Progress Park</li> <li>• 23rd from Penn. to 3rd</li> <li>• 25th especially under 280</li> <li>• The 280 N on ramp at Indiana and 25th</li> <li>• Intersection of Iowa/23rd</li> <li>• Iowa under and alongside 280</li> <li>• Tennessee Minnesota and Indiana between 23rd and 25th</li> <li>• 3rd to Pennsylvania from 25th to Cesar Chavez</li> <li>• Illegal dumping on Tennessee</li> <li>• UCSF staff dumping/littering/cig butts at Tennessee/Mariposa</li> </ul>	<p>Contact 311 when illegally dumped items or litter accumulation is found. These locations were shared with Public Works Operations supervisors for the zone and will be included in regular cleanup operations. In addition, Public Works inspection staff will be performing refuse collection service checks in Dogpatch to ensure that all residents and merchants have sufficient garbage collection service.</p> <p>Fix-It is recommending regular mechanical street cleaning for Iowa St underneath 280, alongside Progress Park, to assist with curbside litter removal. Per Public Works, Iowa between 22nd-25th is swept once a week during night shift.</p>

Contractor dumping - (25th between Iowa +3rd)	Fix-It is recommending lighting assessment to be completed by the PUC along this street as the dark street may be contributing to illegal dumping.
Paving condition/street resurfacing (Streets south of 22nd)	**checking with Ed Yee and Edmund Lee**, will provide update soon.
Dead tree removal needed (Tennessee/22nd SE corner)	Public Works will remove.
Graffiti (22nd/Tennessee, 19th/Tennessee, 3rd/20th, 20th/Tennessee)	Fix-It reported to public works via 311, please continue to report to 311 so graffiti does not accumulate. 22nd/Tennessee 8363148 19th/Tennessee 8363161 3rd/20th 8363180 20th/Tennessee 8363196

Concern	Status
MUNI yard at 23rd/Iowa: cleanliness, too much litter, paper debris, food wrappers, etc	Fix-It contacted SFMTA in October 2017 about community concerns around Woods Division Muni Yard. SFMTA Maintenance of Way manager Leo Martinez was notified of litter and debris issues around the Yard and will expedite litter accumulation removal.
Unsafe driving; speeding, Better signage/traffic calming needed: Indiana between 22nd-25th	Fix-It requested that Muni supervisors oversee operators going from the terminals and record their speed levels, and ask the transit planner at Woods to create an operator and staff bulletin to remember not to speed around the neighborhood.
Stop sign needed - (Minn/22nd, Tenn/22nd)	East/West Streets have stop signs, North/South Streets do not, will ask Kelli Rudnick if her project will address those concerns and provide additional stop signs or, should we request through 311.
Traffic calming- (Indiana from CC to the 280 on ramp)	Per SFMTA, Sustainable Streets traffic engineers evaluated Indiana St ~2 years ago and found the vehicles per day and traffic speeds didn't warrant traffic calming in that area. Fix-it is looking into re-evaluating traffic calming needs based on community feedback and Fix-It observation. Engineers are reevaluating and will provide recommendations soon.
Better 1-way signage (Indiana)	Contacted SFMTA, waiting to see if they have suggestions
Double parking at school on muni line; lack of safety personnel, narrow street is unsafe during -8:30-9am M-F - (Tennessee/20th, La Scuola School)	<p>We've contacted Andre Wright to see if he can reach out to the school to provide traffic calming suggestions. We are still following up with him to find out who is the correct person from the community (resident, school, parent) to report this to 311 or via email. In the meantime, Questions SFMTA will ask are:</p> <p>A few things for La Scuola to consider:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Are parents instructed not to double park, and encouraged to find other places to park if the loading zone is full?</li> <li>2. The loading zone is from 8a-6p; are teachers parking in the zone restricting parents from using the zone?</li> <li>3. Do all of the kids begin/end at the same time? Could there be staggered start/end times to spread out the vehicles coming to the school at one time?</li> <li>4. Has the construction next door completed? Depending on what's there now, maybe La Scuola could ask if they wouldn't mind their white zone to be extended in front of their property...?</li> <li>5. Do parents pickup/drop off their child only? Or are they also socializing with teachers or other parents while parked in the loading zone?</li> <li>6. Has La Scuola/neighbors called parking enforcement to ticket vehicles in violation?</li> </ol>

No left turn enforcement - (Indiana/Mariposa)	We are checking with SFMTA to see if they plan to install lights at this location, Waiting to hear back from Adrienne, will ask SFPD to provide enforcement.
Feel unsafe to walk around day and night with dogs and kids (Around Indiana and 25th)	Need more information here from residents.

Sewage/catch basin odor in evening - (Tenn btw 19th-20th)	Fix-It requested follow up from PUC 8354651, Per Kevin Roach at Sewer Ops , The Sewer Ops Tech went out on 12/6/2017 and flushed out an overflowing sewer vent at 3277 19th street. Per Mr. Roach if the residence still smell sewage please call the Sewer Ops at 1-415-695-2096
Lack of lighting on Tennessee St and Minnesota St between 20th St and 22nd St	Fix-It is recommending a lighting assessment in this area.

Mitch Salazar of DPW who manages a team trained to clean on and off ramps will institute regular cleaning at Indiana and 25th Streets
Old PD station cleanliness, messy construction site is unsafe (20th/Tennessee)	BSM has received no complaints as of December on these properties, Please report concerns via 311, Fix-It Team will visit the area and report concerns in December 2017.
Blighted building (20th/3rd, NW corner)	BSM (bureau of street use and mapping) has received no complaints as of December on these properties, Please report concerns via 311, Fix-It Team will visit the area and report concerns in December 2017.
