

**Wolverine Band Boosters
Executive Board Meeting
Tuesday, June 21, 2016**

The meeting was held at Beef O'Bradys and was called to order at approximately 6pm by President Danny Prejoles.

Present

Meeting Format

The purpose of the meeting was to touch base on things we all had been working on and to update the board on any new developments as the start of band camp get closer. There was no formal agenda for this meeting.

Kari

Kari's husband has been working on a design for the clothing racks needed for the uniforms. If he makes them, it will cost approximately \$168 for 5 racks.

Kari is going to contact NWA Restaurant Supply to get quotes on her concession stand equipment needs. Albert will also put this list on the band website to see if we are able to get donations from anyone in the group. She will also be looking at getting pricing from other sources and seeing what we can get donated from vendors.

Lynn

Lynn is working on getting a final bid from Simply Divine Catering for our before game meals. The catering company is looking to see what donations they can get from their vendors before completing their quote. We should have that shortly.

Heather

Heather reported that \$300 was spent on building the prototype prop which was in line with what we approved at the prior meeting.

Heather explained that with band camp quickly approaching we need to get several things done very quickly. We need to get the jugs ordered for the kids soon so we have them in time for camp. The price at Academy was \$4.99 per jug. Someone suggested checking into ordering them from Walmart and possibly using someone's employee discount. This will be further discussed at the next meeting.

We also need to get started on obtaining donations for the band camp and the coming year. Sometimes it takes a while to get requests approved. Heather stated that Tyson will be able to provide all of the tortilla chips for the concessions stand for the first year.

Kaleigh

Kaleigh said that the students are doing well and really appreciate all that the WBB is doing for them. She would like to see more of the individual section leaders getting their groups together so they get to know each other better prior to band camp.

Keith

The prototype is done – it was very challenging to put it together but he is happy how it turned out and that it is very durable. They are looking for some 6” wheels for all of the props. Kari was going to see what kind of price her husband could get on some as they are usually quite expensive and he can get a discount at places.

We would like to bring the prototype to First Friday on July 1 and let people see what the names on the wall might look like. They are either going to get some fabric and have Ashley Prejoles paint it or possibly get a printer Cammy Jo knows to print it on fabric and add grommets to it so it can easily be mounted on the prototype.

Albert

The file for banner was sent off to Staples. Staples has donated the banner and it will be ready in time for First Friday.

The polo shirts are being ordered for the band and will arrive in time for the school's grand opening on July 29th. The kids will be wearing khaki shorts and the polo shirts for the opening ceremony.

Besides being able to pay for their kid's accounts, there is now a section on the website where someone may make a donation to sponsor all or part of a specific student's expenses. We realize that a small percentage is being taken out for processing fees and are working on a way to stop this from happening.

In regards to getting donations from people to put their veteran's names on the wall, it was suggested that maybe someone put together a press release and send it out to various papers in the area to see if they would run the story. We could also send the press release to the Mayor of Centerton and other officials. Cammy Jo said she would look into this. Another idea was to see if we could get something sent out on Peachjar via the school district.

Cammy Jo

Cammy Jo requested that everyone update the signature line of their WBB mail account to reflect the latest updates which include the spirit store and the donation site.

We all confirmed that the amount of emails she was sending out to the group was appropriate and we appreciated how she keeps everyone up to date within the WBB.
