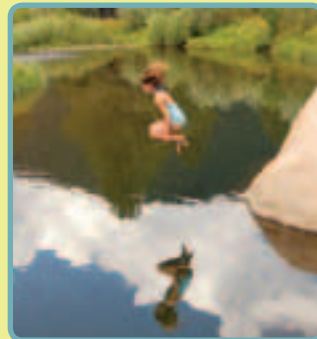

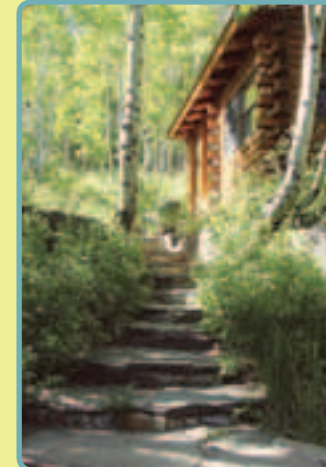
SPECTACULAR SPRING SKIING!
