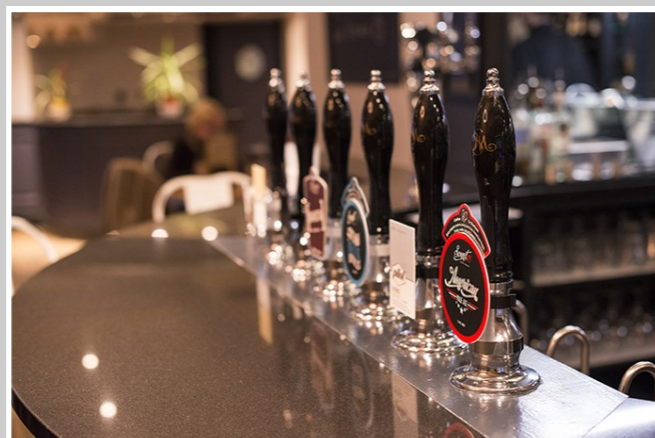
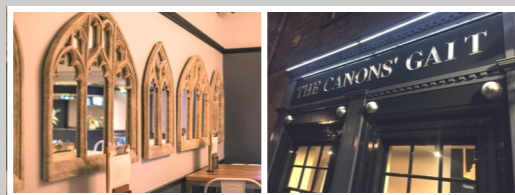

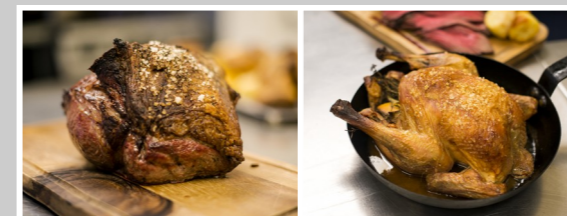

CUMBERLAND BAR & BEER GARDEN



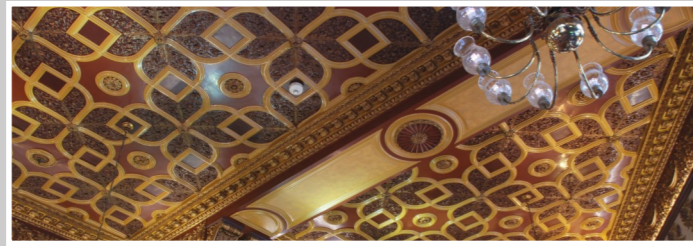
