Start date: August 29, 2016 (or sooner)

Roles/ Responsibilities:

- Work in a team to develop and localize the Power2Girls curriculum
- Outreach to target communities to plan and implement program delivery
- Facilitate the curriculum in target communities (Yes, this means you will be the educator in the classroom!)

Qualifications:

- College/University student or recent graduate
- Experience volunteering/working with youth
- Ghanaian nationality

Our change-agents are:

- Experienced and comfortable with talking about sexual health topics with youth
- Passionate about girls' empowerment

- Able to follow through with commitments

Time commitment: May vary depending on the project schedule.

- August 22- September 9: Must be available 3-5 days during the week for at least 5 hours a day for training, curriculum development, and site visits.
- September 10- October 31: Must be available 3-5 days a week, in the afternoons, for visits to communities/beneficiary schools and programs
- Occasional weekend commitments
- Change-agents must be available for the entirety of the 2.5 month project schedule (August 22 - October 31)
- Possible opportunity for continuation of contract or promotion after 2.5 month project period.

Compensation: This is a temporary contracted volunteer position. Change-agents will receive a weekly stipend to cover transportation, meals, and phone credit.

Location: Office is located in Trasacco, near Islamic University College, but program delivery will be in various locations throughout Greater Accra.
