



## FEELC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION

Thanks to the generosity of the Philpot family and our community, the FEELC Scholarship Program is available to assist qualified families with the cost of tuition at the Center. The FEELC Parent Board will review applications and award scholarships to the two families who show the most financial need among the pool of applicants each year. Because qualification is relative to the financial need of the pool of applicants in a given year, families that do not receive the Scholarship one year are encouraged to apply in succeeding years.

The **FEELC scholarship is awarded between September 1st through August 31st of each school year. FEELC provides two (2) tuition assistance scholarships per year.** These scholarships will provide two families with **\$50 per tuition draft to be used towards payment of their FEELC tuition (for a total of \$1,300 per year).** Scholarship applications are reviewed and processed confidentially by the FEELC Parent Board, who will base their decision upon 1) family enrollment eligibility and 2) families with the greatest financial need.

Note that while all requests will be fully considered, we are only able to offer two scholarships for the school year at this time. However, we anticipate that as the scholarship fund grows through future donations and fundraising efforts, this will allow the Center to potentially provide additional scholarships in the future.

The FEELC Parent Board will use the following eligibility requirements and application process to award the scholarships.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible for a FEELC scholarship:

1. Each family must be enrolled at FEELC full-time or have accepted a full-time placement at FEELC for the current school year (September 1st through August 31st).
2. To receive the scholarship, each family must NOT be currently receiving any child care tuition assistance from NIH, EPA, or the State of North Carolina.
  - a. If a family currently receiving FEELC scholarship funds becomes eligible for receiving tuition assistance from NIH, EPA, or the State of North Carolina, the family must notify FEELC immediately so that the remaining scholarship funds for the school year can be awarded to the next eligible family who applied with a complete application during the most recent scholarship award review cycle.
3. Each family must complete and sign the application and provide relevant documentation each year for consideration.

## **FEELC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION (cont.)**

### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Applicants must complete and submit the attached application form and required supporting documentation to the FEELC Director [by August 10, 2018](#). Incomplete scholarship applications or those submitted after the due date will NOT be considered.

The Parent Board will notify all applicants of their decision [by August 24, 2018](#).

Applicants must agree to the method for scholarship payments as outlined below.

Signing the application form indicates an understanding and acceptance of the eligibility requirements as well as the scholarship payment method as stated in this program information document.

### **SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT METHOD**

Recipients will be charged a bi-weekly tuition rate that is reduced by the scholarship award amount for one school year (i.e., the recipient's bi-weekly tuition rate will be decreased by \$50.00 for one year).
