When to Arrive

Services begin promptly at the scheduled time on your High Holy Days calendar. Please plan to arrive with plenty of time to park, enter, and find your seats. Please follow the directions of our Metro Police officers for parking.

Service Etiquette

Our services involve a lot of standing and sitting. The rabbi will give instructions on when to stand and sit.

- Cell phones and tablets should be turned off before entering the Sanctuary. If you need to have your phone on, please make sure it is set for silent mode.
- When finding seats, please move toward the center, allowing late-comers to find seat without having to climb over you!
- Please be sensible about saving seats for family members. We will be crowded!

Babysitting

Children are welcome at all major services. Babysitting is available in the Academy wing by **pre-registration only**. Details are available online. Please be thoughtful of your neighbors.

Medical Emergencies

In case of medical emergencies, find an usher. They know the location of medical supplies and/or a doctor if needed to help you or your family.

*If you are a physician, you might let the ushers know where you are sitting in case of an emergency.
