IASDR 2017 invites paper (3,000-5,000 words) or poster (250 words) submissions from three areas of design research:

1 Fundamental Research

within a University (disciplinary and interdisciplinary): Including history, theory, and criticism which addresses philosophical arguments that are basic to design.

2 Collaborative Research

University + External Organizations: Development of new methods, innovation, and user experience.

3 Research in Practice

Public, Non-profit, Corporations, and Consultants: Strategies and case studies that apply to the practice of design in government, industry, and consulting, including service design, interaction, products, product systems, environments, and architecture.

Review Criteria

IASDR 2017 is looking for high quality papers (3,000 – 5,000 words) that demonstrate scholarship and research rigor. The criteria reviewers will use include:

Originality

Quality + Research Rigor

Clarity of Communication

Formatted to IASDR2017 Style Guidelines.

Please ensure that you have met these criteria before submission. Please check, proofread, and format your paper submission according to the [IASDR2017 Style Guidelines](#). To assist the review process, please do not include authors' names or institutional details in the review version of the paper. Do not include any reference to your own publications. These details will be added later if the paper is accepted.

All papers will be double blind peer reviewed by two independent reviewers. Final decision will be made by the review committee and communicated to the authors by April 30, 2017. Submissions will only be accepted through the conference submission system Re: Research. **Please follow the [instructions](#) to submit at www.iasdr2017.com/**

Proceedings + Presentation

All accepted papers and posters will be published in the IASDR 2017 proceedings in digital format. Authors are expected to attend and present their paper/poster at the Conference.
