MISSIONARIES OF THE WEEK

Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem

This coming year, remember to pray for Israel and the peace of Jerusalem.

Psalm 122:6, “Pray for the peace of Jerusalem; May all who love this city prosper.”

THANK THE LORD FOR:

- Our Jewish patriarchs Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob for their life of faith.
- The land of the Bible (Israel).
- Our Savior Jesus Christ, Who was born as a Jew and Who will come back as the Lion of the tribe of Judah.

PRAY FOR:

- The veil of deception to be removed from the eyes of the Jewish people. *“Lest you be wise in your own conceits, I want you to understand this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.”* (Romans 11:25-27)
- God to cancel the plans of the enemy against His nation Israel, especially the plans to divide Jerusalem. *“The LORD frustrates the plans of the nations and thwarts all their schemes.”* (Psalm 33:10)
- God to protect the Israeli Defense Force, Israeli Air Force, Israeli Navy and the nation of Israel. *“Behold, He who keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.”* (Psalm 121:4)
- Intercessors around the world to be raised up who can pray wholeheartedly to be the watchmen and watchwomen for Israel. *“I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; They shall never hold their peace day or night. You who make mention of the LORD, do not keep silent.”* (Isaiah 62:6)
- All Israel to be saved; we pray that all Israelis—Jews and Arabs, Orthodox and secular, religious and irreligious—will be delivered from the bondage of tradition and the anti-Jesus culture, so that they will be open to the Gospel of our Lord and saved by our Redeemer, Jesus Christ. *“And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: ‘The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob...’ ”* (Roman 11:26)
- The salvation of Arabs and for the reconciliation of Jews and Arabs.
- For Israeli believers to shed their fear of persecution and share the Gospel with their friends and family. *“For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.”* (Romans 1:16)
