BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENING

Blood pressure screening today is in the Foyer by the stairwell. This is a good opportunity to keep your eye on your blood pressure readings. If you are on BP meds, it will tell if they are working correctly; or maybe you need meds but don't know it. High blood pressure rarely has notable symptoms, but left untreated, it can cause a stroke.

YWAM/Educating for Life

A teacher-training program for special education teachers and parents of kids with disabilities

“Praise God for all the great people we have met, for His provision and for the changed lives of the participants.”

We have been in Papua, New Guinea, since January 3. During this time, we have run four teacher training programs, made many speeches and held meetings with community leaders. It's been a very fruitful time, and it's not over yet! We have extended our time so we can do one more training in Madang. We are currently living on Kranket Island off the coast of Madang. Last Monday, we started a ten-day course with the people here. They are hoping to start schools on the island and in nearby villages.

Staying here to run another course also means we need to buy new return tickets home. I felt God wanted us to accept this request, so we did. There was a lot of transformation amongst the students in both Port Moresby and Mt. Hagen. People understood that God can be a part of every subject in school and that teachers can play a major role in teaching children to love and serve God.

The pastor stated that this was the most powerful training he has seen. One participant said he'd been to teachers' college, but after what he has learned in this course, he feels like a real teacher and can't wait to get into the classroom to teach!

We've had struggles along the way. Cayden got dengue fever and was very sick for a week. He's better now. God has seen us through each rough spot.

Pray:

- For this program and for us, please. It's making a difference in the lives of teachers who in turn impact students and families.
- That we have the funds to get new tickets home and know exactly when God wants us to go home. There are more invitations to run trainings. We want to only do them where God directs.
