For centuries, their nation had been in exile. For six days, surrounded by enemies, Israel stood alone...and changed history. This spring marks the 50th anniversary of the Six-Day War and a CBN documentary film commemorates this historical battle with the new movie, “IN OUR HANDS: The Battle for Jerusalem.” **This Tuesday (5/23)** is a special one-night showing—you can experience the story of Israel's extraordinary battle for survival fifty years ago. In May of 1967, Arab nations joined together with a stated goal to wipe Israel off the map. Less than 20 years after reforming as a nation, Israel was on the verge of extinction.
