### Operation Dignity — Ghana

#### PRAISE GOD FOR:

- An up and down year for Operation Dignity. We are so grateful for the opportunity to serve our Heavenly Father in Ghana. We have grown in project development, learning the culture, identifying the right people—God is good to provide. In November 2016, what we thought was 5,000 acres to be developed into a farming opportunity turned into 45,000 acres with a promise of more. ODI was overwhelmed. Mark Holmquist and Jim Sullivan went to Ghana in February 2017 and were able to identify strategic partners that potentially are able to support this undertaking. This area is more Muslim than the other villages where we served, so the opportunity for the Gospel is greater. We are not sure “why us,” but thank God and are trusting His grace.
- Izaiah's very good year. We are so thankful for his spiritual growth and development this year.
- A business analytics class at Bethel University that used ODI as a project this semester and served us amazingly well in three areas: proper website development, donor content management, and predictive analytics for our Fish Farm project. THANK YOU, BETHEL!
