HEAT SAFETY TIPS

Here are five common sense tips to keep you safe:

1. Increase your intake of non-carbonated, caffeine-free beverages, such as water or juice.
2. Wear clothing that is light-colored and loose-fitting.
3. Avoid the outdoors during extreme heat. Stay out of the sun. Stay in air-conditioning, if possible.
4. During extreme heat, eliminate strenuous activity such as running, biking, and lawn work.
5. Eat less food, as it will increase metabolic activity/heat. Increased metabolic heat increases water loss.

PRAISE GOD FOR:

- The 7,000 pastors in training in Africa.
- The completion of three new Tier 2 courses for our trainers.
- The start of T-Net training in two new countries: Senegal and Burkina Faso.
- Forty pastors graduating in Tanzania in July.
- The growth in Rwanda (400 pastors) and the growth in Botswana (300 pastors).
- Finding country leaders for Uganda and Burkina Faso.
- Our daughter Bethany's baby boy, due in November.

PRAY FOR:

- My summer travel schedule:
 - June 28–July 4: Nairobi to do some promotions with pastors.
 - July 5–11: Dar es Salam, Tanzania. I'll be training the country board and oversee a graduation of 40 pastors.
 - July 18–23: Glen Eyrie, Colorado for our yearly T-Net board meeting.
 - August 11–19: Ougadougou, Burkina Faso. This is a new T-Net country and it is 60% Muslim. There is great excitement among the pastors there to be better trained in disciple-making!
 - September 9–19: Accra, Ghana. I'll be training a number of graduates along with four other country leaders in Tier 2 courses for T-Net trainers.
- The Kenyan churches and Christians as there are continued attacks by terrorists from Somalia.
- My health, that I will stay well. Also pray that my luggage will arrive safely.
- The pastors who are receiving this training, that they will use it well and wisely so that the Great Commission will be fulfilled in Africa.
- Lana, that she will be protected and well while I'm gone from home for over three months from July – November 2017.
- New supporters to be provided that will add \$1,800/month needed for my work with T-Net.
- Me as I seek foundation monies to help finance our current ministries, as well as fund future projects.
