### HEALTH TIPS OF THE WEEK

**Balance Your Blood Sugar:** Research studies indicate that low blood sugar levels are associated with low overall blood flow to the brain, which can jeopardize your ability to make good decisions. To keep your blood sugar stable, eat a nutritious breakfast with protein such as eggs, protein shake or nut butters. Plan to eat smaller more frequent meals throughout the day. Feel free to plan a protein-packed snack between meals. Also avoid eating 2 to 3 hours before bedtime.

**Smart Snacks:** Raw nuts, seeds, healthy, low sugar granola, low sugar fruit, hard boiled eggs, plain Greek yogurt mixed with berries, mini pack of nut butters, cottage cheese and healthy jerky.
