- The preparation for all of the activities, courses and seminars that we are developing in order to reach Israelis with the Gospel and to disciple believers. All of the logistics tend to fall on me as the facility manager, but we have a great team, and they are happy to run programs! So, please pray as I develop the courses and do the advertising and registration.
