Romans Chapter Eight - Session 6 Romans 8:18-27 "From Groaning to Glory"

Big Question: How do believers think about <u>SUFFERING</u>?

1) Suffering doesn't compare to the coming GLORY (8:18-19)

Logizomai — a numerical <u>CALCULATION</u>

Present SUFFERING VS Future GLORY

"God uses a spade of sorrow to dig a well of joy."

—E.K.Bailey

2) CREATION Groans: because suffering is pervasive (8:20-22)

Creation is referring to the **IRRATIONAL** creation.

GROAN = Stenazo = intense yet <u>INAUDIBLE</u> sigh.

3) WE Groan: because we suffer while we wait in hope (8:23-25)

We have the **DOWNPAYMENT** of the Holy Spirit.

While wait suffering PURIFIES our desires (1 John 2:15-17).

Modern "hope" is WISHFUL thinking.

VS

Biblical hope is a future **CERTAINTY**.

4) The <u>SPIRIT</u> Groans: because He intercedes for us (8:26-27)

The groaning of the Holy Spirit is...

- INAUDIBLE just like the groaning of creation and believers
- Without SOUND or WORDS
- In alignment with the <u>WILL</u> of God
