Working with Us

Project Guidelines

Invoicing

A work order is created at the launch of each project detailing its anticipated scope, including materials/services required and related costs. The client is responsible for providing complete billing contact information at the time the work order is generated. Billing contacts cannot be altered at a later stage of the project. Clients may request a copy of the work order upon placing an order, but we do not provide it by default.

The work order is converted to an invoice upon project completion. The invoice may differ from the work order if modifications or changes were made to the order during production, such as additional proofing, retouching, etc. Our basic prices are subject to change without notice and are non-negotiable. Projects of significant scope, particularly large projects involving multiple in-house services (ie. digital + mounting) may qualify for discount pricing.

Final work is released for shipment, delivery, or pick-up once payment has been remitted in full. Payment can by made by U.S. check, money order, wire transfer, or credit card (Visa, Mastercard, or American Express accepted). Clients with account privileges will receive statements on the 15th of the month. Statements unpaid after 30 days forfeit discounts. Interest of 1.5% is applied monthly to overdue balances. Clients with accounts 60 days past due are put on a C.O.D. basis until full payment is received. Color Services retains a security interest collectively and individually in products and services delivered to clients for which individual and accrued accounts remain unpaid.

Shipping

Completed projects for which payment has been received in full may be shipped from Color Services to the destination of the client's choosing. Our default shipping vendor is U.S. Priority Mail, but we will ship via UPS, Fedex, DHL, or another vendor upon request. Shipping charges will be applied to the client's Fedex/UPS account number, if available. Otherwise, shipping costs will be added to the final invoice. Local deliveries (Greater Boston area, and occasionally Providence, RI or NYC) is available for a custom fee. Contact us directly for more details.

Film Processing Turnaround Times

- E-6 and C-41: We commit to same-day turnaround for all color film received before 3pm.
- Black & White: We commit to 24-hour turnaround for all B+W film.

Film Processing | Other Pricing

Push & Pull Pricing

We will push or pull film for an additional cost.

For B&W Film:

- Push or pull up to 3/4 stops = Add 50% to regular processing price
- Push or pull 1 or more stops = Double regular processing price

For C-41 and E-6 Film:

- Push or pull up to 1.3/4 stops = Add 50% to regular processing price
- Push or pull 2 or more stops = Double regular processing price

Pricing for our standard 8 $1/2 \times 11$ " contact sheets is provided below. We also offer enlarged contacts up to 16x20 in B+W and 30x40 in color. If you would like your contacts done in or out of film print files, please let us know when placing your order. Turnaround for contacts is 24 hours. Enlarged contacts take 3 days.

Custom grade prints are cropped and sized to general specifications. Density and contrast are determined by our techicians under the guidelines you provide. These prints will satisfy most requirements, particularly with a good negative. However, if further adjustments are needed, we will accommodate an upgrade to presentation grade.

Exhibition grade fiber printing is offered for those who require the highest level of interaction during the printing process. We will provide up to three separate tests for your approval before making the final print.

Exhibition C-Prints

These are handmade analog prints. A well-made optical print from a good negative offers a level of depth, immediacy, and beauty not generally associated with other printing processes. C-prints are available in widths up to 72".

For an additional fee we will also provide a matching reference print and keep it on file for future printing.

C-Print Turnaround Time

Normal turnaround time for C-prints is 3-5 days. Rush fees apply. Two-day turnaround adds 50% onto the print cost. One-day turnaround adds 100%. Same-day turnaround adds 200%.

Scanning & Workstation

Scanning & Image Capture

Our scans are manually dusted/cleaned and set to the specific resolution and size of final use. Originals larger than 11x14 and especially delicate works will incur an additional \$25 image capture charge. Final scans are permanently archived and available for retrieval at any point in the future. Files can be delivered digitally via WeTransfer or Dropbox for no extra charge. We can also burn to a CD or DVD for \$10 and \$25 respectively. Scans are not delivered until full payment has been remitted.

Scanning & Workstation (Cont.)

Digital Workstation

We have extensive experience restoring and refining photographic art. Image retouching, restoration, and manipulation is billed at an hourly rate of \$150.

Workstation time is billable for any image requiring transformation beyond basic color correction, cropping, and clean-up. Two hours of workstation time is included for all exhibition inkjet printing orders.

Each image is charged a minimum of one hour. Additional time is calculated in half-hour increments.

Pigmented Ink Printing

Custom Inkjet Printing

Our pigmented ink prints are produced on an Epson 11880 Inkjet printer. Custom inkjet printing will satisfy most requirements, assuming the digital file supplied is of appropriate quality. No proofs are included, but letter-size test prints can be purchased for \$25 each. If further adjustments are needed, we will generally accommodate an upgrade to **Exhibition Inkjet Printing.**

Please note that we have a \$50 minimum fee for all digital print orders.

Exhibition Inkjet Printing

Those who require significant collaboration and consultation during the production process should consider exhibition printing. For a \$200 setup fee, we will provide:

- Up to 3 8x10 proofs;
- Up to 2 hours of workstation time for needed adjustments.

The setup fee is billed in addition to the final print cost (see table below). Additional proofs or workstation time may be added as needed and are billed a la carte.

Mounting

We offer a variety of backing options. Selection of material will depend upon the size of the print, the level of archival quality required, and final look desired.

- 4-Ply & 8-Ply Rag: an acid-free museum board with moderate flexibility.
- Gatorboard: a firm, paper-based foam core. Available in black & white in a standard 3/16" and 1/2". Other colors available by custom order; call for more details.
- Sintra: a durable PVC board, available in standard 3mm or 6mm.
- Plexi: a clear acrylic with greater stability than Sintra, available in 1/8" and 1/4" thickness.
- Aluminum: highly stable metal sheets, available in .063 and .080 thicknesses.
- **Dibond:** a hybrid material composed of an aluminum sheet enclosed between two acrylic outer layers; offers the stability of aluminum at a much lighter weight.

Please note:

- If you plan to face mount a print, it must be backed on plexi, aluminum, or dibond.
- If you plan to attach a hanging system, the print must be mounted on aluminum or dibond.

Face Mounting

Face mounted images must be backed on plexi, aluminum, or Dibond. They must also be printed on glossy paper. The paper finish will not affect the final look; rather, the face mount material determines whether the piece will have a reflective or matte finish. The first 2 items in the table are reflective; the bottom 3 are not.

Hanging Systems

All aluminum hanging systems are custom-made in our lab and attached with an industrial adhesive. The width of the hanging system will determine how far the piece will float off the wall once installed. Larger pieces require wider hangers for adequate support.

Unfortunately, we cannot attach hanging systems to prints that have been mounted on Gatorboard, ply mat, or Sintra. The print must be mounted to aluminum, plexi, or Dibond.

We also offer z-clips as a cost-effective alternative to our custom hanging systems. Pieces installed with z-clips will be flush to the wall, and will not create the same float effect as our aluminum hangers. They will offer reliable security for small and moderately-sized works up to 48×60 . Our z-clips are priced at \$10/ft (based on width).
