| Key Vocabulary | Definition |

| Force | A push or a pull. Forces can change the movement of an object. |
| Contact Force | Some forces need two surfaces to touch, in order for a force to occur. Friction is a contact force. |
| Magnet | A magnet is a rock or a piece of metal that can pull certain types of metal towards it through magnetic force. |
| Magnetism | Magnetism is a natural force that attracts or repels certain metals. |
| Magnetic field | The magnetic field is an area around a magnet in which there is a magnetic force. |
| Magnetic poles | Either of the two ends of a magnet where the field of the magnet is strongest (North and South poles). |
| Lodestone | A rock that is naturally magnetic. |
