



IMPORTANT NOTICE

President Obama just announced immigration relief for individuals that meet requirements similar to what is commonly referred to as the DREAM Act. The new policy will allow many people currently in the United States without status to obtain legal work authorization.

Individuals must meet the following requirements:

- Be 15-30 years old,
- Entered the United States before age 16
- Been in the U.S. for at least 5 years as of June 15, 2012 (entered no later than June 15, 2007)
- Remained in the United States since June 15, 2007
- No felony, significant misdemeanor or multiple minor misdemeanor convictions
- Currently in school, graduated or has a GED, or an honorably discharged veteran
