- 1) It was not blasphemy for a man to claim to be the "Messiah"; indeed, the Jews were anxiously awaiting the Messiah's arrival, that he might deliver them from political oppression.
- 2) One of the most fundamental ideas associated with sonship in biblical thought is that of inheritance.
- 3) In the Incarnation of God in Christ, the Infinite has encompassed the finite on the basis of the attribute of personhood shared between the Creator and the human creature.
- 4) When the Bible says that Jesus "learned obedience through what he suffered," it means that he learned to stop disobeying.

- 8) We look back on his death and know that, in the mind of God, we were there. Our sins were on him, and the death we deserved was happening to us in him. Baptism signifies this death with Christ.

- 10) Jesus Christ is not a tribal deity. He does not belong to one culture or one ethnic group.
